Brown Swiss sold for \$40,235

HARRISBURG - The Pennsylvania State Brown Swiss Association conducted its annual invitational sale in conjunction with the Pennsylvania All-American Dairy Show, Monday night, at the Farm Show complex, here.

A total of 43 calves and mature females went under the hammer and grossed \$40,235 for an average of \$980 per head.

The top of the sale was a four-year-old cow, "Braxton Stretch Toni," from Pittsboro, N.C. Martin and Esther Daubert, from Pine Grove, Pa. paid \$3200 for the animal. Runner up honors in the dollars sweepstakes went to another four-year-old,

"Zumbo Victoria," from West Newton, Pa. The cow was again purchased by the Dauberts, for \$2,075.

A July calf donated by the William R. Daubert family of Pine Grove was sold for \$310. The proceeds from that will go towards youth work in the state organization.

A senior heifer calf consigned by Leon Button of Rushville, N.Y. was purchased for \$1125 by Daryl Simpson from Michigan. The highest selling junior calf was one consigned by Roy Arnold of Lexington, N.C. and purchased by Jesse S. Patterson of Clayton, Del. Don and Carol Trimble of Peach Bottom consigned the

junior calf which brought the second highest price - \$530.

Aside from the 43 animals sold, the "Pennsylvania All-American Invitational Brown Swiss Sale" also offered semen from "Welcome In Stretch" Ampules sold for as much as \$290 each. "Beautician"

semen was sold at \$45 per ampule.

The sale was sponsored by the Pennsylvania Brown Swiss Association and managed by J. Rohrer Witmer, Willow Street, president. Auctioneering was done by A. Doty Remsburg of Jefferson, Md.

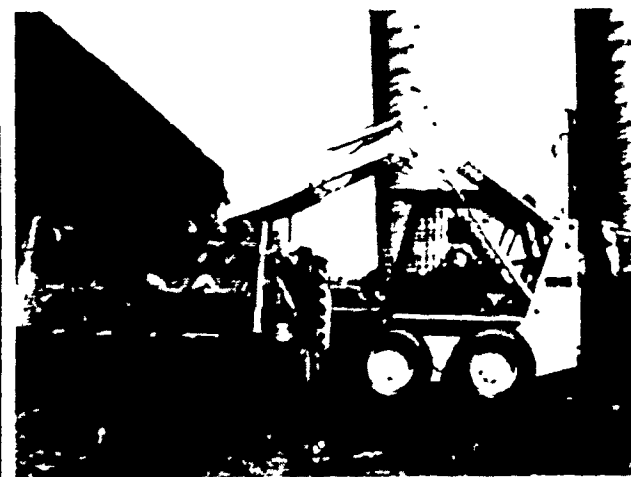

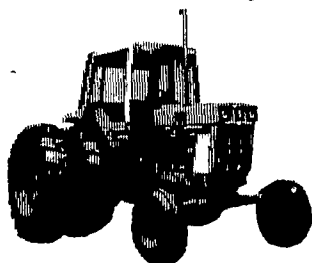
