

## Candidates in special series

HERSHEY, Pa. - Political candidates from South Central Pennsylvania will confront one another on a new prime-time series produced by WITF-TV, Channel 33, Hershey, beginning Friday, October 8, at 9:30 p.m. The four part series of 90-minute programs, called "The Voting Machine," will feature candidates running in state legislative and U.S. Congressional races in WITF's ten-county coverage area.

During the programs, each dealing with a specific population center, candidates from that geographic area will make opening statements and then discuss

the issues with political journalist John Baer and a local member of the League of Women Voters.

Scattered throughout the programs will be specially-produced spots designed to provide basic voter information, including a demonstration of the operation of a voting machine and a tongue-in-cheek cartoon mini-series called "Field Guide for Candidate Watchers," which will identify types of "political birds."

The first "voting machine" program (on October 8) will feature candidates from the York and Gettysburg areas and will be repeated on Satur-

day, October 9, at 2:30 p.m. The complete series is scheduled as follows:

**EPHRATA** - A record price of \$7 per pound was paid by Noah Wenger last week for the champion carcass lamb at the Ephrata Fair. Wenger, who is a candidate for the 99th District State House seat, authorized that the money be donated to a charity of his choice. The previous record price for such a sale was \$6 per pound, set in 1974.

The champion lamb, a Dorset, belonged to Barbara Herr of Narvon Weighing 46 pounds on the rail, it had

earlier placed third in on-the-hoof competition. Steve Strauss' 56-pound Hampshire was the reserve champion of both the live weight and on rail shows. WGSA radio of Ephrata paid \$2.50 per pound for the animal.

## Pa. hog route restricted

NEW YORK, N.Y. - State and federal hog cholera quarantines on New Jersey swine have been lifted, the U.S. Department of Agriculture has announced. Still in effect, however, are state restrictions on swine shipments into Pennsylvania. Swine owners in New Jersey should contact state animal health officials before shipping hogs into Pennsylvania.

Although quarantines have been lifted, a concentrated surveillance in Gloucester and Cape May counties will be continued. APHIS officials emphasized that testing of blood serums of slaughter hogs will be a major part of the surveillance. A cooperative state-federal hog cholera task force has been in operation since Aug. 2, the day after the disease was confirmed in Cape May county.

## Soybeans way up

WASHINGTON, D.C. - U.S. stocks of old crop soybeans are estimated at 244 million bushels as of September 1, USDA reported last week. The figure is up more than a third from a year ago and 49 per cent above the Sept. 1974 level. The only year to top it was 1969 when 327 million bushels were on hand.

On the farm soybean stocks totaled a record high 85 million bushels, up 10 million bushels from the previous high set a year ago. Off the farm stocks, at 159 million bushels, are up 44 per cent from a year earlier.

The big carryover came despite a September 1975-August 1976 disappearance of 1.46 billion bushels that was up 22 per cent from the previous year.
