

## Chrysanthemums blooming at Rutgers University

FLEMINGTON, N.J. - October is chrysanthemum time at the Rutgers Display Garden. Both early and late flowering varieties can be seen in a colorful array of yellow, white, pink, red, and bronze blooms.

The garden is located off Ryders Lane, just east of U.S. Route 1 overpass in New Brunswick.

The yellow varieties to be seen are Classic, Golden Tranquility, and Sunburst Cushion. Included in the white varieties are Penguin, Baby Tears, and Minnwhite. The pinks are Grandchild, Elegant Cushion, and Stardom.

The red and bronze varieties were selected for flowering in October. Cooler

weather permits the darker colors to develop without fading.

The garden is open every day until dusk.
