

Commission tours Md. counties

ANNAPOLIS, Md - The Maryland Agricultural Commission will tour the dairy and fruit heartland of Maryland October 14 and cap the day with a public meeting to discuss agricultural concerns with farmers from Washington, Frederick, and Carroll counties.

The tour as outlined by commission chairman William Kleinwachter is as follows: leave Maryland Artificial Breeders Co-op (Sire Power) at 8 a.m.; visit Way of Truth Industries, Hagerstown, dairy operation; visit W.D. Bromley & Son fruit operation near Smithsburg; visit Ross Smith, Jr. turkey production operation at Graceham; and visit the Harold Long dairy farm near Thurmont.

The tour will be completed by an inspection of the Maryland Artificial Breeding Co-op's operations in the early afternoon followed by a business meeting session of the commission.

At 7:30 p.m. the commission will then host an open public meeting at the Holiday Inn, on Patrick St., Frederick. All farmers and those connected with

agricultural businesses are invited to attend the meeting and will be given the opportunity to ask questions concerning commission business, the Maryland Department of Agriculture, or just to bring to attention any agricultural concerns they may have.

The commission is a 17-member citizens advisory group whose members are appointed by the Governor for three-year terms. They represent all major commodity production groups in the state.

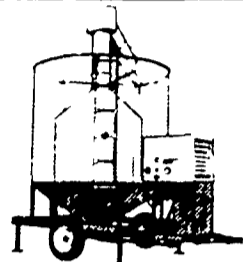

A small, lightweight travel iron, (with an international plug) can be taken anywhere for handy, cost-cutting touch-ups you can do yourself.

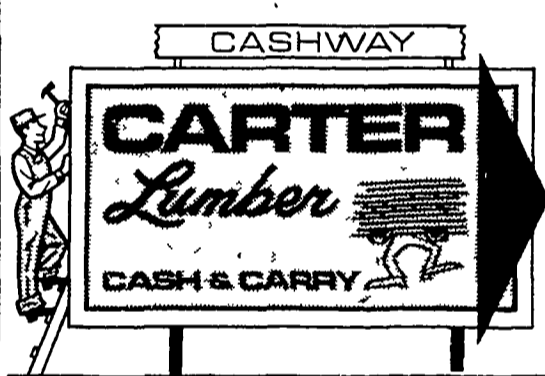

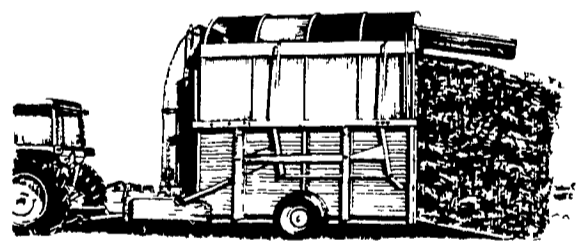
