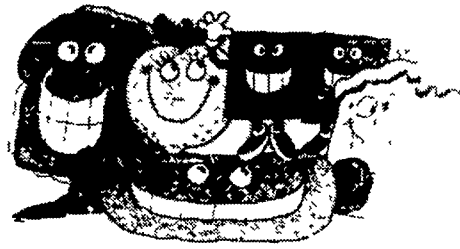


MILK IS A NATURAL

Brighten home with dried flowers

UNIVERSITY PARK - To brighten a home during dreary winter days, try decorating with dried flower and plant arrangements.

The size, pattern, and color of the container are important when making such arrangements. The

container should never overshadow the plants - the plants should be the center of attention.

The shape and size of the container indicate the type of arrangement best suited to it. Oval or round shapes are best for circular designs,

while tall containers look best with vertical lines.

Inspection fees raised

it's Fall!

NEW YORK, N.Y. - The U. S. Department of Agriculture announced increased fees for voluntary grading and inspection services for fresh and processed fruits, vegetables, nuts, and related products. The new fee schedules became effective Oct. 24.

Officials of USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service, which administers the inspection and grading services, said the higher fees are necessary to offset additional operating costs, including salary increases authorized by Congress.

Under the new fee schedule, all regular commercial inspection fees for fresh fruits and vegetables will be increased by \$2 per lot and the hourly rate will be increased from \$13 to \$14. Inspection fees for processed fruits and vegetables will include an increase in the regular hourly rate from \$17.40 to \$18.45. Commensurate changes have been made in other fees involved. Inspection is authorized under the Agricultural Marketing Act

of 1946. Inspection and grading services are voluntary and made available upon request of financially interested parties. The Act requires fees for service to be reasonable and, as nearly as possible, to equal the cost of rendering the service.
