

Cumberland Co. names top 4-H boy, girl

CARLISLE, Pa. - Cumberland County 4-H Clubs announced the selection of several of its members to receive recognition for their 4-H work. Beth Hemminger, Centerville, and Tim Wentz, Carlisle, were chosen 1976 Outstanding 4-H Girl and Boy of Cumberland County. They were presented a trophy sponsored by the Carlisle Kiwanis Club at the 4-H Achievement Night Banquet held in the beginning of October.

Beth Hemminger, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Floyd Hemminger, has been a 4-H member for nine years. She has taken 4-H Projects in clothing, dairy, cooking, recreation, vegetable flower gardening, forestry, wildlife, health and photography. Beth has been a teen leader five years, 4-H Keystone winner in clothing in 1976 (top 10 in state) and a member of the state 4-H flower judging team in 1975-76.

Tim Wentz, a five year 4-H member, is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Alan Wentz. He has taken 4-H projects in horse, woodworking, field crops,

Cherry crop nearly halved

HARRISBURG, Pa. - The 1976 tart cherry crop in Pennsylvania totaled 3800 tons, a decline of 40 per cent from the 6,300 ton total production in 1975, according to the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service.

The small crop is primarily the result of spring freeze damage and continued poor pollination weather.

An estimated 87 per cent of the 1976 crop, 3300 tons, was used for processing. The remaining 500 tons were sold in fresh markets or utilized on the farm.

The total United States production of tart cherries

for 1976 was 73,200 tons. This represents a 50 per cent decrease from the 145,250 ton total production of 1975.

This year's crop was utilized with 300 tons for fresh market and 69,200 tons being processed.

The average price per ton received by U.S. growers was \$501, compared to \$206 per ton in 1975. The value of this year's crop, at \$36 million exceeds the 1975 value of utilized production by \$11 million.

Pennsylvania's 1976 sweet cherry production totaled 460 tons, a decrease of almost 47 per cent or 400 tons from the 1975 crop, according to the

Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service. Production in the three Great Lakes States - Michigan, New York and Pennsylvania - was 12,560 tons, down 51 per cent from 1975.

United States cherry production totaled a record 164,210 tons, up eight per cent from last year and four per cent above the previous record set in 1973.

The 160,980 tons utilized were valued at \$61.3 million, down from the \$62.5 million of a year ago. The average price, at \$381 per ton, decreased from the \$411 received per ton in 1975.

Tax course offered

UNIVERSITY PARK - The annual Farm Income Tax and Social Security Short Course for 1976 will be held from December 6 to 10 on the main campus of the Pennsylvania State University.

The 1976 Farm Income Tax and Social Security Short Course has been completely revised to include tax developments as they pertain to child care, self-employed retirement, and the annual employer's return.

Members of the Internal Revenue Service and Social Security Administration will join University staff in discussing filing requirements, reporting depreciation, treatment of other income, completing the 1040, Social Security, prorating expenses, filing

corrected returns, net operating loss, capital gains and losses, investment tax credit, changes in income averaging, special tax matters, involuntary conversion, balance sheet, Pennsylvania corporation tax, preparing for an informal audit, and how to be a good tax practitioner. Special emphasis will be placed on Public Law 94-12 (Retirement Plans HR-10 and IRA) and itemized and standard deductions.

The registration fee is \$40 for Pennsylvanians and \$45 for non-Pennsylvanians. Please do not pay in advance; fee is payable at registration time on December 6, 1976.

Advance application is desirable since facilities may limit the number accepted for the course.
