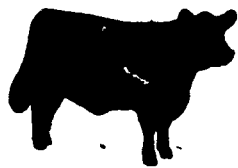

Oklahoma City Oct. 28, 1976
 Estimated Receipts 11,500 Same day last week 13,454 Moderately active, Feeder Cattle and Calves generally steady except feeder heifers over 500 lb. steady to 50 cents lower, instances 1.00 lower on Choice grade. Majority receipts mixed good and choice and choice 400-750 lb. feeder steers and 350-650 lb. feeder heifers; fairly large attendance buyers.

FOR THE WEEK: Compared to late last week, feeder steers over 600 lb. 50 cents to mostly 1.00 lower, steers under 600 lb. generally steady; feeder heifers over 500 lb. steady to 50 cents

lower, some choice heifers 1.00 off; feeder heifers under 500 lb. generally steady; cows recovered the early loss to close near steady; bulls under extreme pressure and 2.50-3.50 lower; salable receipts near 29,300 head compared to 37,587 last week and 26,752 the comparable week a year ago. Cows comprised 14 per cent of the cattle receipts numbering near 4,100 head or 800 head less than the previous week; feeders made up 85 per cent of the total.

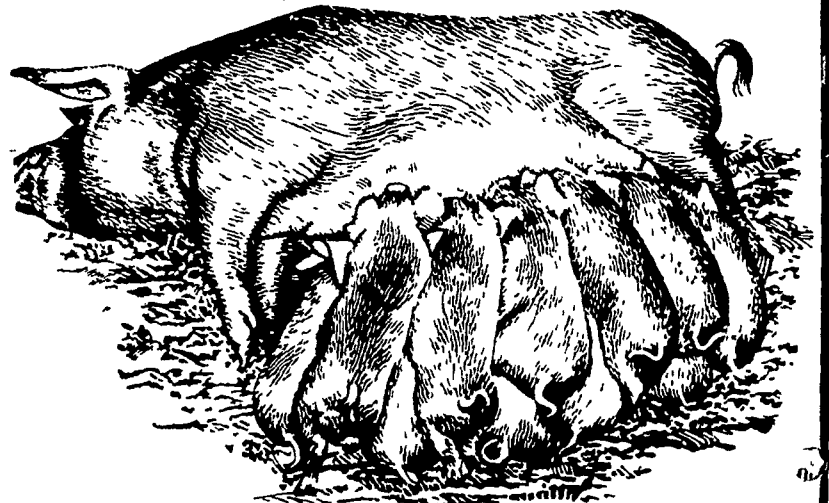
