

## Sheep industry film receives award

DENVER, Colo. - The motion picture titled "The American Sheepman: A Way of Life" produced by the American Sheep Producers Council has received the Chris Bronze Plaque in the Columbus Film Festival, the oldest film festival in the United States.

The film, which stars Jim Davis and a number of sheep producers from across the country, is presently being distributed by Modern Talking Picture Service to schools, producer groups

and television stations nationwide. To date, over four million people have viewed the 27½ minute film.
