Weaver expands, expresses optimism

NEW HOLLAND, Pa. - Weaver Quality Eggs, Inc., a subsidiary of Victor F. Weaver, Inc., New Holland, will move its present operation from the New Holland based plant. The new facility will include all procurement, processing and shipping activities associated with the egg operations.

The facility, leased from High Realty, Inc., Lancaster, will have processing and shipping areas totalling 50,000 square feet. The production and processing at the present Weaver Quality Eggs Plant is under a USDA continuous inspection program, plus a

Pennsylvania certified program. The new Lancaster facility will continue both of these inspection programs on all shifts.

Facilities designed with the future in mind, are available to double present shell egg processing operations. New shell egg grading equipment will be capable of processing 57,600 dozen eggs or 691,200 eggs per day in two eight hour shifts.

The plant will also include facilities to process both eight pound fresh and frozen liquid egg products. Three

Seymour egg breaking machines capable of producing 150,000 pounds of liquid eggs per week will be installed in the breaking operation. The breaking operation facilities are also designed to expand production capabilities in this area when necessary.

Weaver Quality Eggs, Inc. has made an investment in the future of the egg industry, and is confident the egg industry in Lancaster County, will continue to help retain the state of Pennsylvania as the fourth largest egg producing state in the nation.
