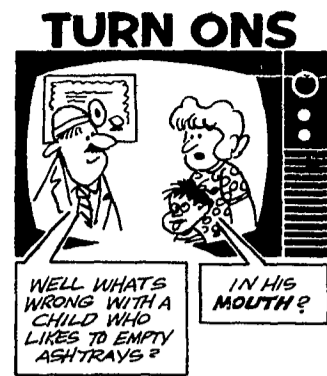
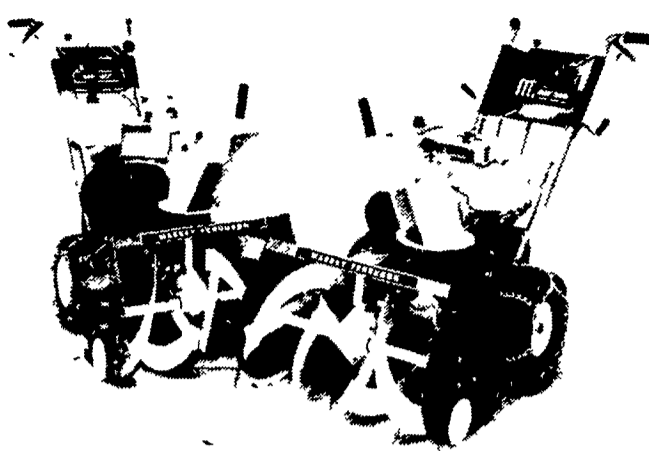

NEW SNOW BLOWERS - FROM MASSEY-FERGUSON

Massey-Ferguson's new MF308 - a self-propelled walk-behind snow blower engineered for heavy snowfall areas - features improved impeller design for greater snow-throwing range and capacity.

One of two new snow blowers from Massey-Ferguson, the MF308 cuts a 26 inch snow swath with power from its 4-cycle, 8-horsepower winterized engine. The 5-horsepower MF305, designed for medium snowfall areas, chops a 24 inch swath. Both new snow blowers are double stage, with high capacity augers for inhaling snow and high speed impellers for blowing it away.

The machines are arbio disc-driven and have wide diameter discharge chutes to eliminate clogging. Deadman shutdown control and wideset, heavy-duty tubular steel handles increase operator safety and handling ease. Both machines come with tire chains as standard equipment.

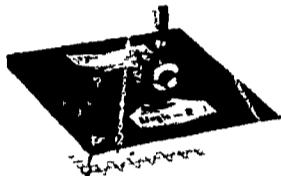

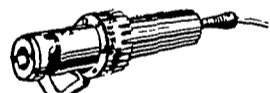
