1 teaspoon cinnamon
½ teaspoon nutmeg
¼ teaspoon cloves
1-½ cups quick oatmeal
½ cup coconut
½ cup chopped nuts
Cream butter and sugar. Beat in eggs; add pumpkin

and vanilla. Sift in dry ingredients. Stir in oatmeal, coconut and nuts. Bake at 375 degrees F. for about 12 minutes.
