Second high lactation was completed by a Kinzers. Jammy produced 25,961 pounds of milk, 950 bounds of butterfat with a 3.7 per cent test in 305 days.
The herd of Curtis E. Akers, Quarryville, had the Tighest daily butterfat average. This herd of 60 registered nighest daily Houltein cows averaged 54.4 pounds of milk, S.11 pounds of butterfat with a 3.9 per cent test. The herd Sf Jonas E. Zook, Quarryville, placed second. This herd of 37 registered and grade Holstein cows averaged 53.4 pounds of milk, 2.07 pounds of butterfat with a 3.9 per cent fest.
