



## DHIA MONTHLY REPORT

Edwin Funck's "Carol" was the milk production champion in Lebanon County's December DHIA summary. The 6-year old Holstein recently completed a record of 25,114 pounds of milk, with a 3.0 test, and 754 pounds of butterfat. The butterfat crown went to "Emma, a 7-year old Holstein in the Raymon and Marlin Getz herd. She produced 21,863 pounds of milk, with a 4.2 test for 925 pounds of butterfat.
