ITALIAN CREME CAKE

1 stick margarine $\frac{1}{2}$ cup shortening 2 cups sugar 5 egg yolks 1 teaspoon vanilla 2 cups flour 1 teaspoon soda Dash of salt 1 cup buttermilk 1 cup coconut 1 cup nuts (chopped) 5 egg whites, beaten stiffly

Mix together margarine, at 250 degrees F. for 30 to 45 shortening, sugar, egg yolks, minutes. Pour into flat pan stirring occasionally. Cool. and vanilla. Add flour, soda, and salt mixture alternately with buttermilk. Stir in coconut and chopped nuts. Fold in last five egg whites, beaten stiffly.

Pour into 2 (10 inch) or 3 (9 inch) pans. Bake at 350 degrees F. for 30 minutes. Frosting:

1 (8-ounce) package cream cheese

¹/₂ stick margarine 1 teaspoon vanilla

 $2-\frac{1}{2}$ cups confectioner's sugar

Beat above together until smooth. Frost cake when cool.


