Performance tested bulls for sale

UNIVERSITY PARK, Pa. - The gross income from a beef cow herd is based primarily on three things: percent calf crop, weaning weight of calves, and quality of type score, says Ben Morgan, Extension animal scientist at Penn State University.

He askes: "If you are a cattleman, are you satisfied with your production in these three areas? Do your calves grow rapidly? Do they keep growing after weaning? Are they the type of cattle that will continue to grow and go to market at preferred market weight and grade choice with a maximum of muscle or lean meat?"

"If your answer to each of these questions is yes, you are a most fortunate cattleman," says Morgan. "If the answer to any or all of Pennsylvania Department of


the questions is no, then you Agriculture and The Pennshould be considering a bull for the coming breeding season that will improve your calf crop," he adds.

These above factors are affected by genetic make-up and environment. The only way to get bulls of known University Park, Pa. 16802. genetic background is to select bulls that have definite records, explains Morgan.
