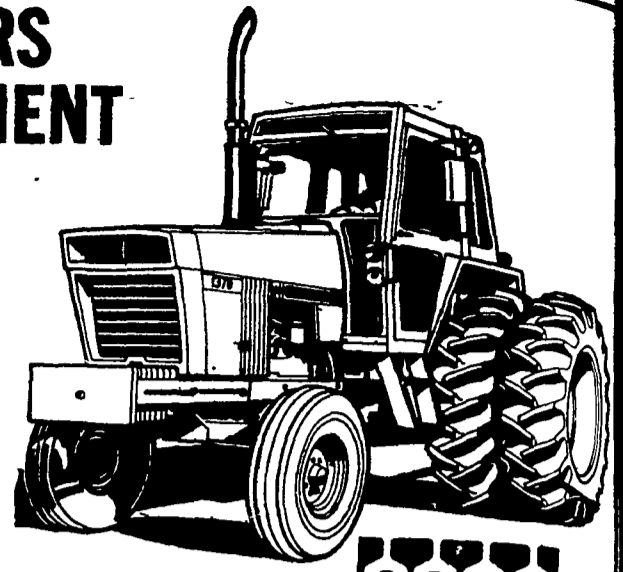
Straw or other suitable bedding is used for the floor. The calf is a proven design that provides a dry, draft-free shelter for the animal. The result...a much healthier calf!

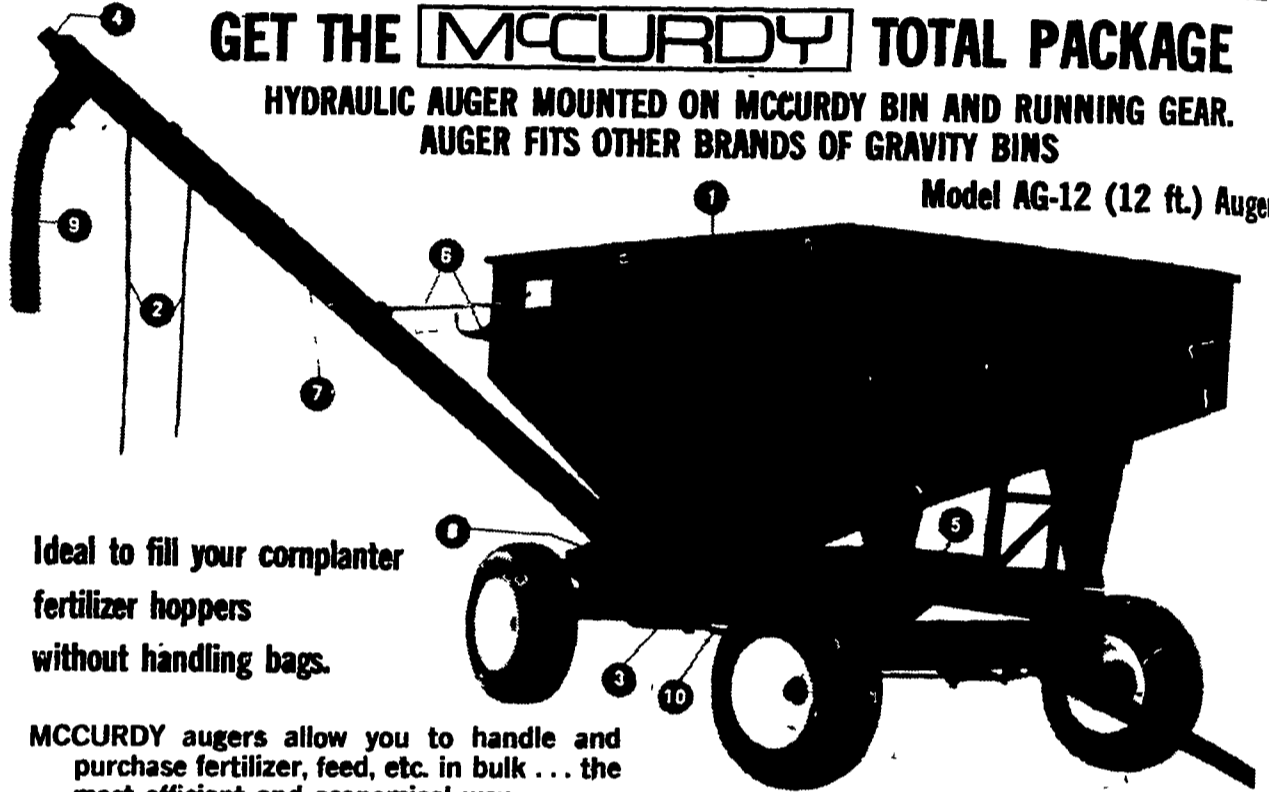

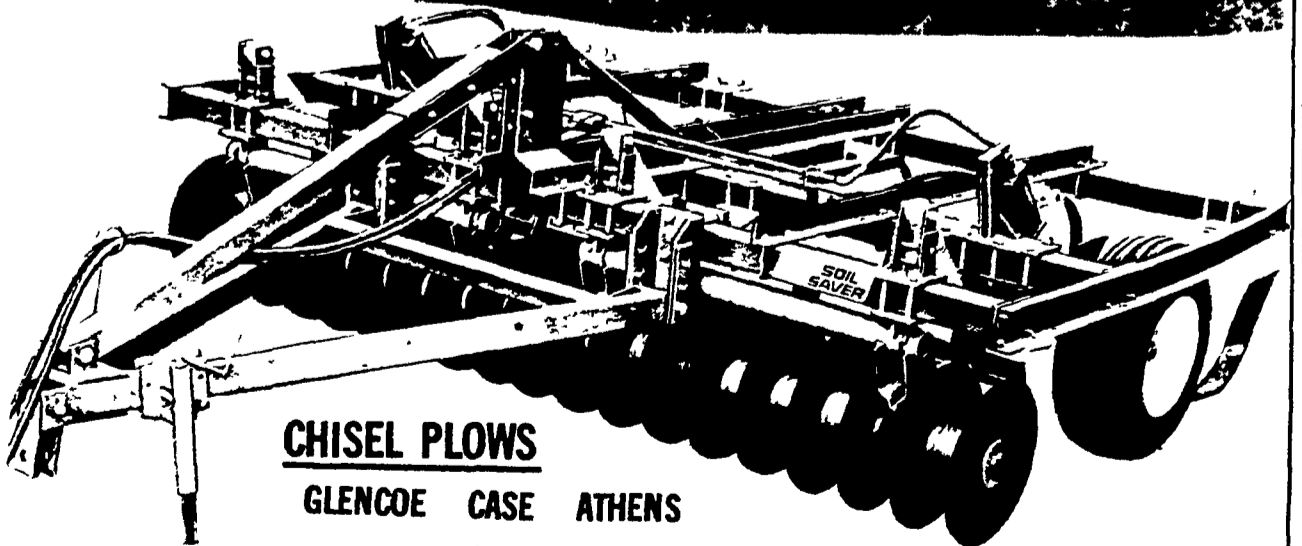
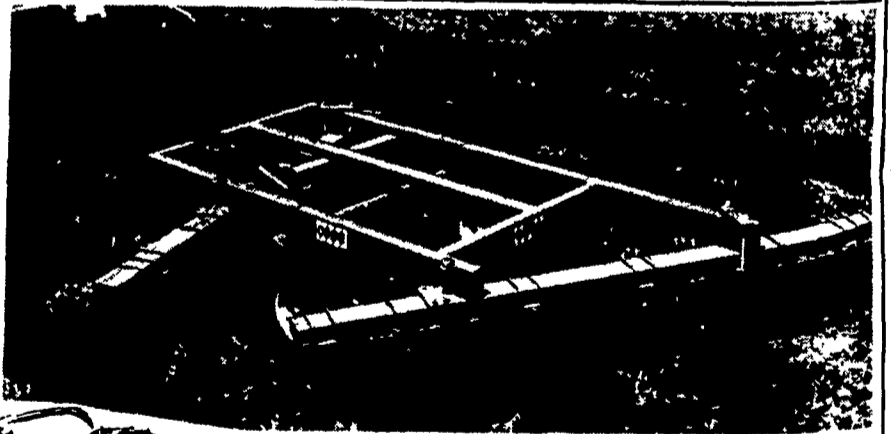
