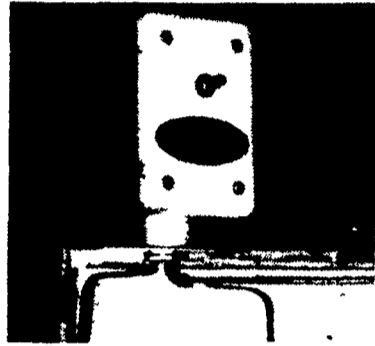

works part-time for LARA, it was learned.

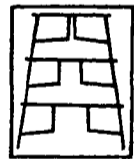

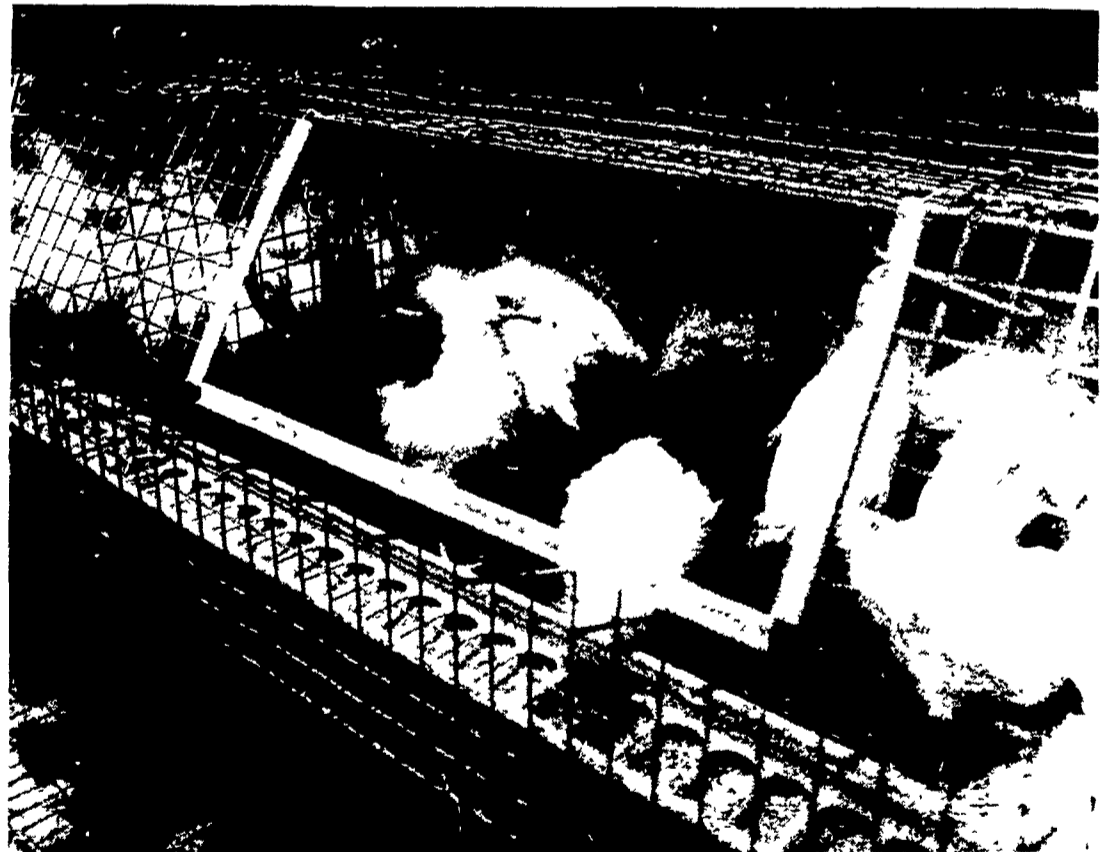
