

Dauphin COUNTY DHIA MONTHLY REPORT

John Hertzler's "Etta" had the highest butterfat production for records completed last month, beating her nearest rival, Robert Schaffer's "Valetin," by a score of 947 pounds to 805 pounds. "Etta" tested 4.3 per cent on 21,946 pounds of milk, which was surpassed by quite a few cows in spite of the commanding lead she had in the butterfat race. Three cows swept past her in milk production, with R. Own Dairy In.'s "No. 32" taking the crown at 23,054 pounds.

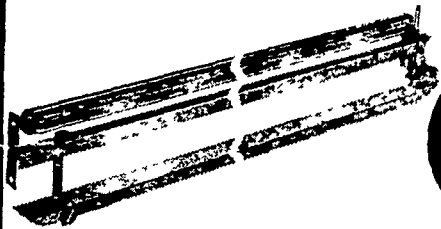

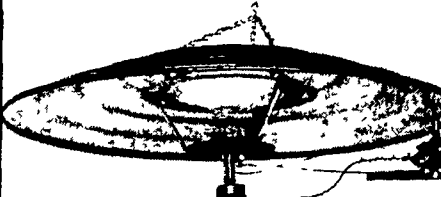
