



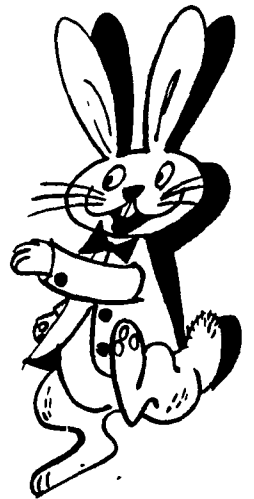
Lebanon DHIA MONTHLY REPORT
