BIRD-IN-HAND, Pa. — Ten dairymen who market their milk through the Eastern Milk Producers Cooperative were given special recognition recently for producing milk with low bacteria counts. Trail favored

HARRISBURG — Rep. Noah W. Wenger, R-Lancaster, has announced that a measure to save the historic and scenic Appalachian Trail has been sent to the floor of the House from committee.

Winger said the bill was overwhelmingly voted out of the House Conservation Committee with an important change made from the original legislation.

The Lancaster County Republican, a member of the Conservation Committee, said he prepared and introduced the amendment to House Bill 3 to insure land acquired by the state to preserve the pathway does not infringe on valuable acreage of designated farmland.

Wenger said the Federal Government will match the amount of money the State decides to spend to save the trail from land developers and private land owners who are currently buying real estate adjacent to the 200-year old path.
