Theme for the annual program will be "Teens take the Lead," with Kick-off

speaker Frank Bortz, associate state 4-H leader, Penn State University, presenting "Hustle to the Beat of Leadership."

Program participants will choose one of the following interest areas for indepth training: "Involvement in Local Government," "Telling the 4-H Story," or "Values Awareness." In-

dividual workshops related to local government will include Pros and Cons of the Equal Rights Amendment featuring panel members from the National Organization of Women and Stop Equal Rights Amendment, Understanding Your Local Government, and Land Use: Private vs. Public Interest.

Teens choosing the "Telling the 4-H Story" program area will concentrate on improving photography skills becoming effective 4-H salesmen, and understanding 4-H as it relates to the mass media. "Values Awareness" activities under the direction of Robert Allen, 4-H specialist, Penn
