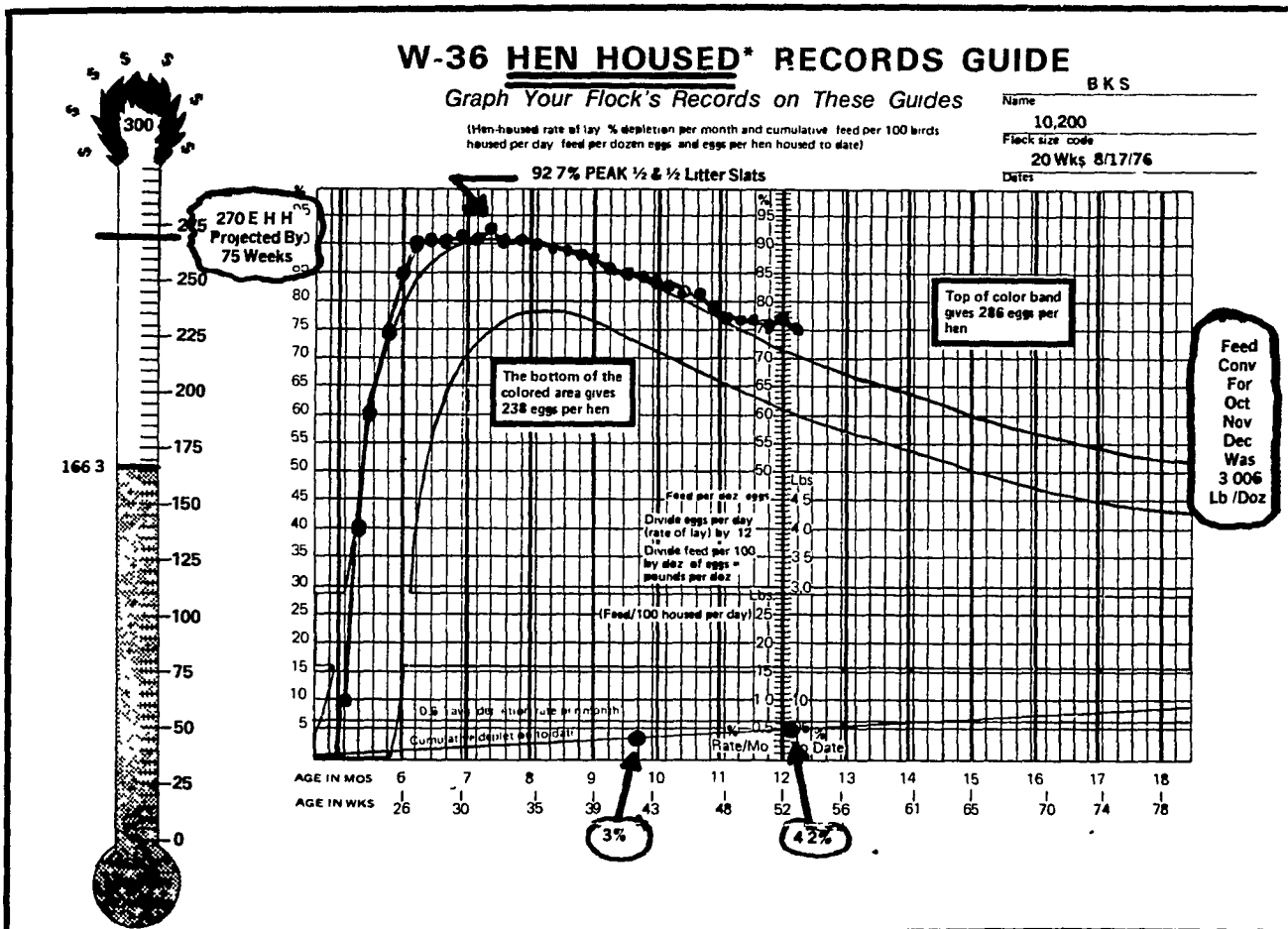




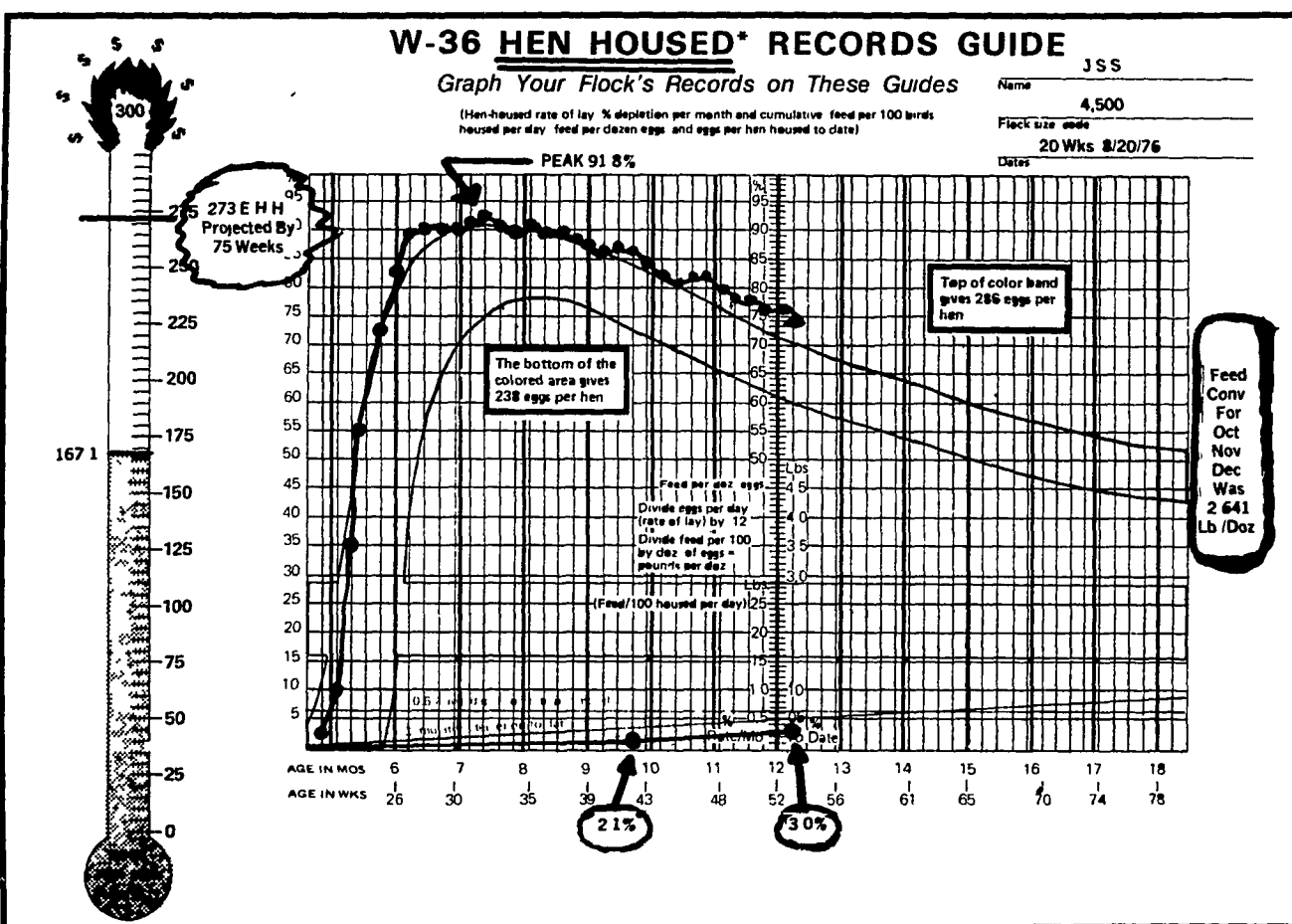

**COMBINATION LAYER Statistics:**

1. Both flocks will have laid in excess of 270 EGGS PER HEN HOUSED by the time they reach 75 weeks of age (52 weeks or production).
2. After peaking at a respectable figure, both flocks are showing a very slow rate of decline (not much over 1/2 percent per week). **(EXTREMELY PERSISTENT!)**
3. Vigor and vitality and health equals losses which average only 0.13 percent to 0.15 percent per week in the laying house. **(EXCELLENT LIVABILITY!)**
4. This kind of production in combination with a small bodied layer will result in both of these flocks converting at under **(3.7 lbs. LOW FEED COST PER DOZEN!)**
