

Registration to begin this week for Sr. Citizen transportation program

LANCASTER, Pa. — The Lancaster County Office of Aging senior citizens transportation program will hold registration for individuals 60 years and older residing in the Manheim and Lititz areas. Registration will be held in the Manheim area on Monday and Tuesday, April 25 and 26 at the Zion Evangelical Lutheran Church, corner of E. High and S. Hazel Streets, Manheim between 9:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Registration

for the Lititz area will be held Wednesday, April 27 - Friday, April 29 at the Lititz Senior Center, 21 Spruce Street, Lititz, between 9 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.

The purpose of this program is to provide those persons 60 years old and older with the essential transportation that is vital to their health and welfare. The priority for transportation will be given for three specific purposes: 1) medical appointments;

social service appointments; and 3) limited food shopping. In special cases, as determined by the Office of Aging, transportation will be provided for 'other' purposes.

In accordance with the program's guidelines, medical appointments include visits to doctor's offices, hospitals and clinics, regardless of the type of doctor visited. Social service appointments encompass such agencies as the Social Security Office, the Office of Veteran's Affairs, and the Department of Public Assistance. Limited food shopping is classified as those necessary trips once a week or twice a month to the major food stores.

Transportation will be provided primarily by the Red Rose Transit Authority buses in accordance with their regular bus schedules. For those who are unable to get to existing bus routes, taxi transportation to the bus

stops will be arranged. For those who require transportation and are unable to utilize the buses or where there is no local bus route, taxi service may be provided in the Manheim and Lititz areas only. There is no taxi service outside of the Manheim and Lititz areas. This program does not replace the existing Medicare program.

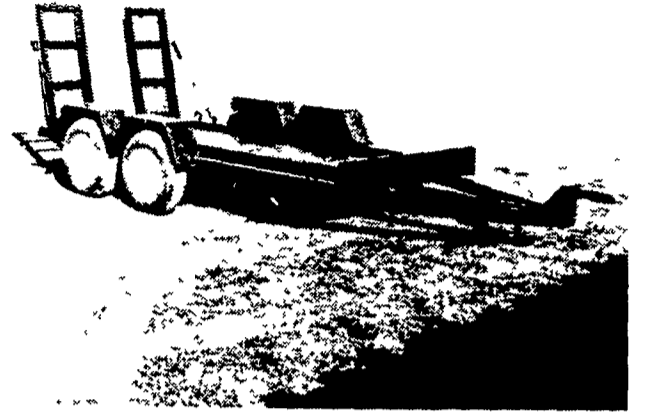
At present the program is being made available to those residing in Manheim, Lancaster Junction, Union Square, Sporting Hill, Penryn, Elstonville, Mt. Hope, White Oak, Pennville, Lititz, Brickerville, Brunerville, Hopeland, Durlach, Newton, Rothsville, Millway, Kissel Hill, Lime Rock, Fairland, and Dirston.

In order to utilize this transportation program senior citizens must register with the Office of Aging staff April 25 and 26, located at Zion Evangelical Lutheran Church, corner of E. High

and S. Hazel Streets, Manheim, and April 27 - April 29 at the Lititz Senior Center, 21 Spruce Street, Lititz.

TANDEM TRAILER

A new medium capacity tandem trailer designed for farm and light contractor use has been introduced by Rink Manufacturing Company, Pender, Neb. The new Rink tandem trailer is said to have a capacity of 10,000 pounds and standard equipment includes an electric brake system,

running lights, four tie-down brackets and 14.5 industrial wheels with heavy duty 6-ply commercial nylon tires. Bed sizes are 6 foot by 12 feet and 6 feet by 14 feet. Runways are constructed of heavy duty No. 4 expanded metal. A choice of round, or flat-top fenders, and a choice of standard drop-gate or bevertail with a 20 degree slope.
