

Forestry scholarships available

CARLISLE, Pa. - Each year the wood-using industries of Pennsylvania, together with Agricultural Extension Service, sponsors a Forestry Training Camp of one week at Stone Valley in Centre County.

The 24th annual camp for both boys and girls will be held from June 26 to July 2, 1977.

The basic purpose of this training camp is to develop in its participants an appreciation of our natural resources—land, water, and forests. Growth, management and wise utilization of these resources are explained to campers through class sessions, field trips, and visits to manufacturing plants. Forestry is the dominant theme throughout the program. Educational and recreational activities are designed to permit each individual to participate and benefit from the six-day program.

The Glatfelter Pulp Wood Company will pay camp registration, board and lodging for a number of individuals, 14 to 18 years old, from Southcentral Pennsylvania.


Diabetes screening, conducted by the Lancaster
