CATTLE: Receipts this week 4800: last week 5100; last year 6200.

Compared with last week's close, slaughter steers closed 1.00-1.50 higher. Slaughter heifers 1.00-1.50, instances 1.75 higher. Cows 1.00-2.00 lower. Bulls steady. Receipts about 70 per cent slaughter steers, 25 per cent slaughter heifers and the balance mainly cows. Slaughter steers and heifers reached their highest level since May of last year.

NOTE: Several loads Choice and Prime 3-4 steers marketed this week.

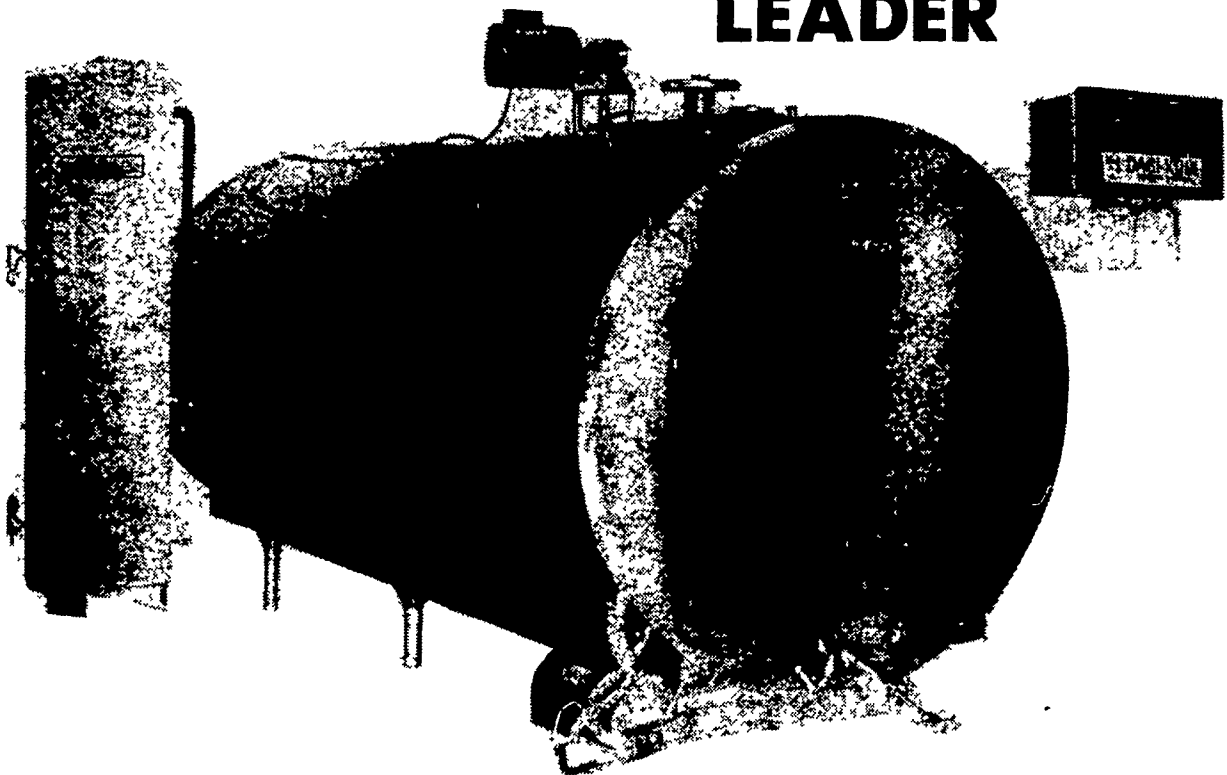
