

Right to Work group formed

HARRISBURG, Pa. - The formation of a political action committee (PAC) to promote the Right to Work principle in Pennsylvania was announced Wednesday by Albin W. Simokat, vice president of Pennsylvanians for Right to Work.

"This PAC will be an important tool for the Right to Work movement, which is working for enactment of a Pennsylvania law guaranteeing all workers the

right to decide for themselves whether they want to join a labor union or not," Simokat said.

"Although public opinion polls consistently show overwhelming support for Right to Work—the latest figure reported by the Roper Organization is 76 per cent in favor—many state legislators have bowed to union officials' demands to ignore the issue because of union

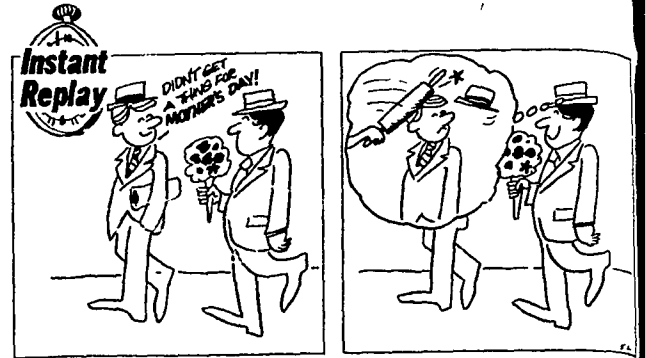
help in their elections," Simokat continued.

"A total of 35 of the 48 state senators (two seats are vacant) in the current session of the State Assembly, or almost three out of four, gained election with the assistance of organized labor. In the State House, three of every five representatives were backed by the Pennsylvania AFL-CIO Committee on Political

Education (COPE)," the Right to Work leader added. The Right to Work Political Action Committee of Pennsylvania, as approved by the Board of Directors of Pennsylvanians for Right to Work, "will participate actively in the election campaigns and provide contributions to, and expenditures on behalf of, those candidates for public office in the state who support Right to Work," said Simokat.

Pennsylvanians for Right to Work is a coalition of employers and employees from all walks of life, including union members, who

believe that every wage earner should have the right to get and hold a job regardless of union membership or non-membership.
