## AFBF visits Israel

PARK RIDGE, Ill. - A foreign trade and study mission of American farm leaders, headed by Allan Grant, president of the American Farm Bureau Federation (AFBF), currently is making a 10-day tour of Israel.

The group of Farm Bureau leaders from 10 states, many accompanied by their wives, are visiting a variety of agricultural projects and meeting with Israeli agricultural officials.

The mission is part of AFBF's continuing effort to improve and expand foreign trade relations. Grant headed a similar mission to Europe last month.

On the return trip to the U.S., the farm leaders will stop off at Rome to meet with officials of the United Nations Food and Agricultural Organization.
