Smoke detector facts offered

UNIVERSITY PARK, Pa. — a smoke detector in your home can give you an early warning in case of fire. It could enable you to escape safely.

According to the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission, most fire victims actually die from smoke inhalation before the heat of flames reach them. Since smoke spreads faster than heat, smoke detectors can help reduce deaths and property loss because fires can be detected and extinguished early in their development.

Two types of smoke detectors are on the market

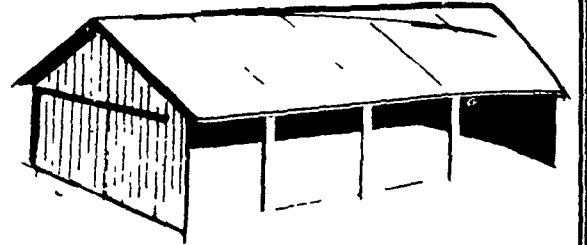
today. One, the ion chamber detector, uses a radioactive source to produce electrically charged molecules (ions) in the air. This sets up an electric current within the detector chamber. In general, this senses flaming fires (such as an armchair ignited by a cigarette).

The second device, the photoelectric detector, uses a photoelectric bulb similar to the electric eye in many automatic doors. The bulb emits a photoelectric beam of light that sets up an electric current in the detector. When the light is obscured by smoke, the flow of electric current is reduced and this sets off the alarm.

In general, the photoelectric detector senses smoldering fires quicker than flaming fires. For additional information

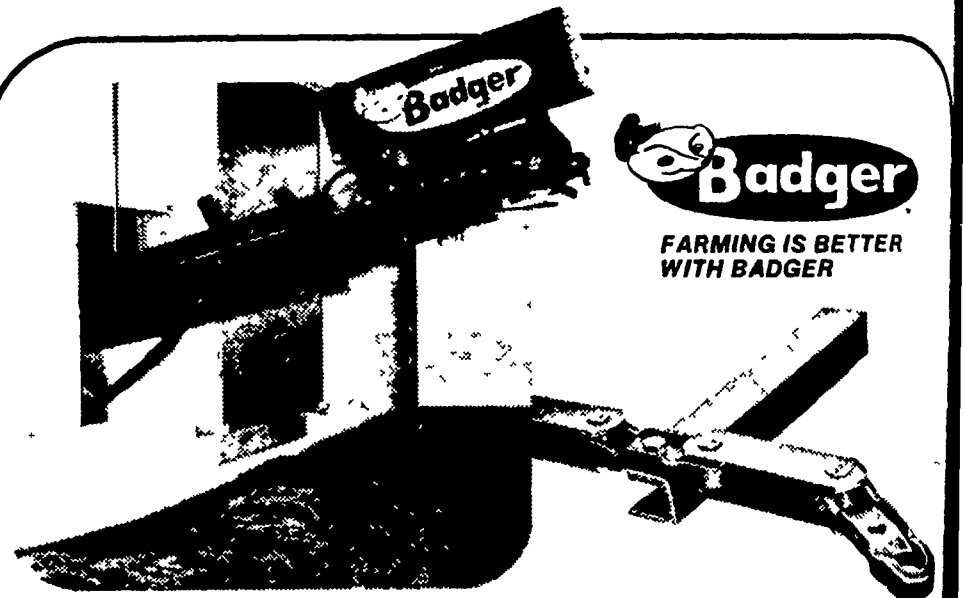
