Here's help for fruit trees

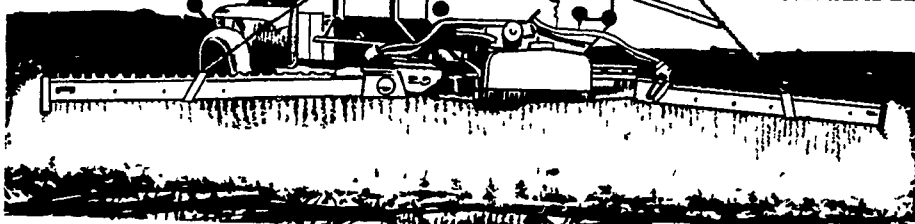
UNIVERSITY PARK - If you have a small home orchard or just a few fruit trees, a seven-lesson course on how to care for trees to ensure optimum fruit bearing can be valuable. Penn State's correspondence course on home garden fruits gives information on applications of fertilizers, principles of pruning, and selection of methods of harvesting, storing, and packing fruits.

A valuable addition to the course is the Home Gardener's Guide to Fruit Sprays - their selection, application, and safety. The spraying timetable tells when to spray, materials to use, and pests to control for apples, stone fruits, pears and quinces.

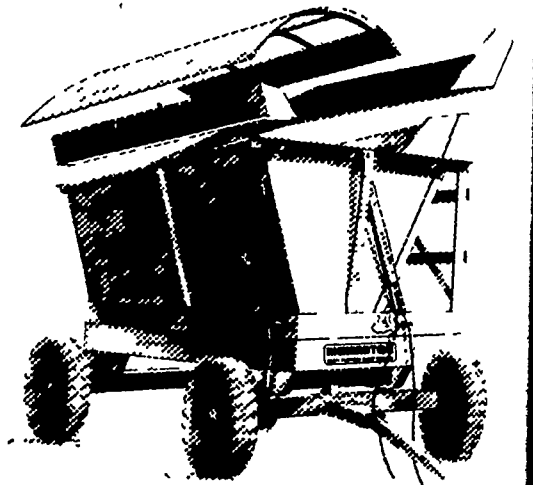

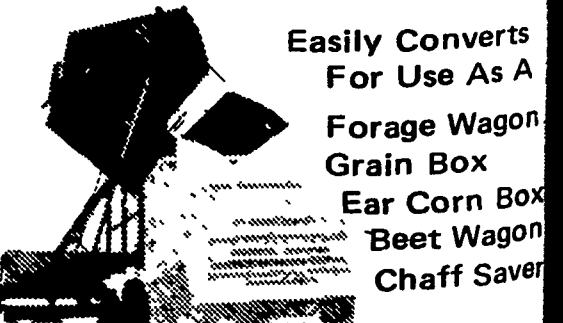
