

Dauphin COUNTY DHIA MONTHLY REPORT

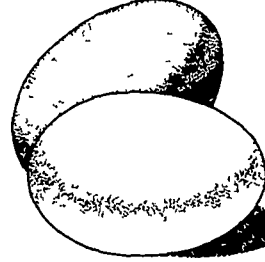
MAY 1977

"Toots," a 10-year old Holstein in Robert Schaffer's herd, completed her lactation with 21,102 pounds of milk, a 3.6 per cent butterfat test, and 762 pounds of butterfat. John Hertzler's "Mae," a 5-year old Holstein, scored with 761 pounds of butterfat, a 3.4 per cent butterfat test, and 22,095 pounds of milk.
