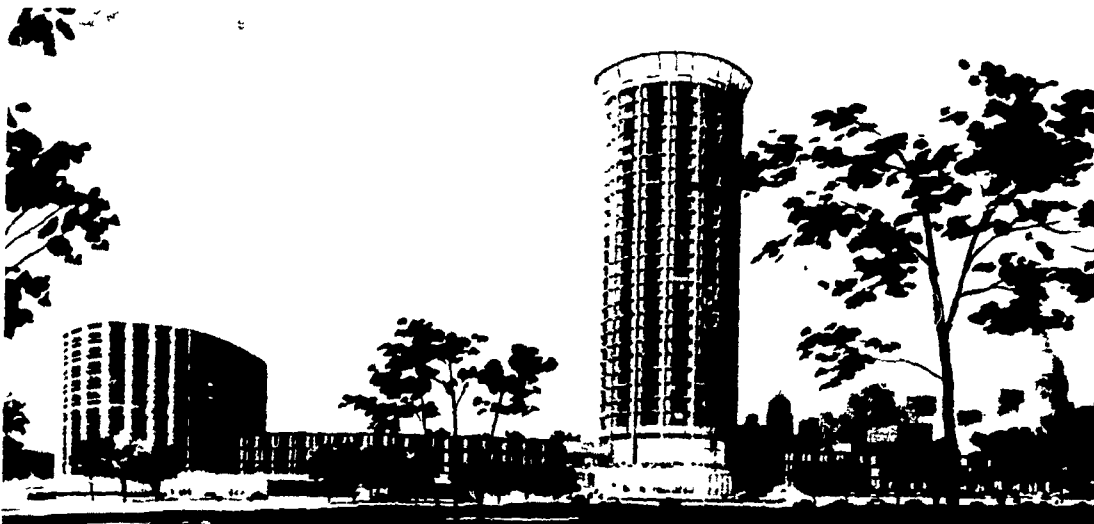

Seminar topics include high-moisture corn for young pigs, swine health, manure management, haylage for sows and finishing rations. You won't want to miss any of these timely and important topics.



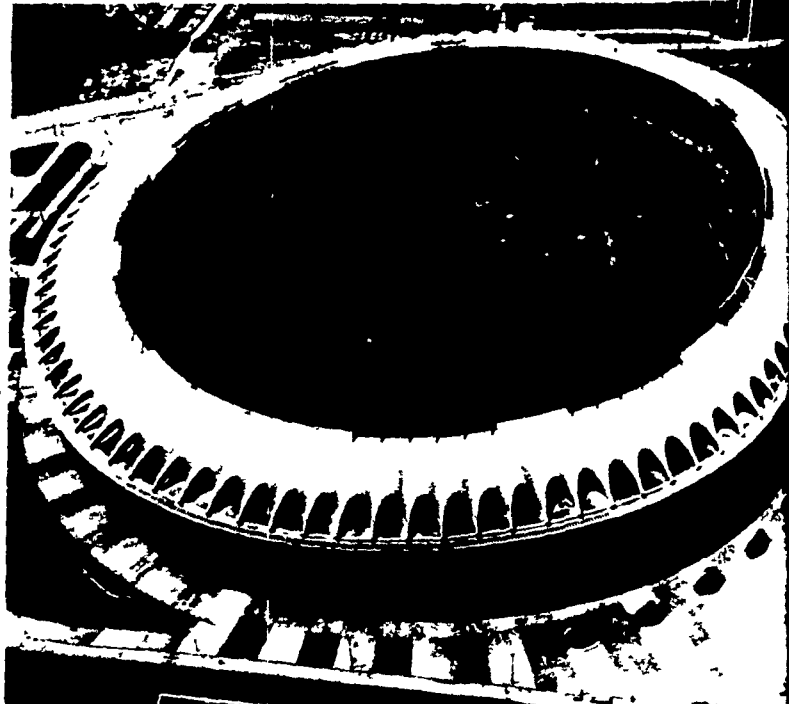
