- 1 can (13 ounce) evaporated milk

- FROSTING Tablespoons butter or vegetable shortening
- 1/4 teaspoon salt 21/2 cups confectioners' sugar 1/4 cup crushed strawberries

### STRAWBERRY SPONGE 1 envelope gelatin

- 1/4 cup cold water
- ½ cup hot water
- 1 cup sugar
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup strawberries (juice and pulp)
- 1 Tablespoon lemon juice ½ cup cream (whipped)
- 2 egg whites

Crush strawberries, add sugar. Soften gelatin in cold water, then add hot water to gelatin, stirring until dissolved. Add berries, salt and lemon juice. Cool until mixture begins to thicken, fold in whipped cream and stiffly beaten egg whites. Pour into individual dishes

#### **CRACKER JACKS** cups brown sugar

#### DELUXE **STRAWBERRY PIE**


- 4 cups fresh strawberries 3 Tablespoons cornstarch

# School reunion planned and school reverse side.






