

4-H focusing on wildlife conservation

education, involvement and decision-making are prime elements of a new national 4-H wildlife conservation program sponsored by Atlantic Richfield management and land use, Foundation through National 4-H Council. Objectives of the program

include utilization of individual and group projects and practices contributing to wildlife conservation; provision of leadership initiative in conservation projects; exploration of career and educational opportunities in this and related fields, and furthering the preservation of natural resources.

Emphasis will be on youth involvement in planning and carrying out innovative wildlife conservation projects at state and local levels. Special grants, totaling \$12,000, are being offered to selected states submitting proposals for model wildlife conservation programs in 1977.

In addition, in-depth wildlife training in conservation he will

Center, Washington, D.C., Aug. 7-13, for two selected 4-H members from each state. The training will emphasize multiple use concepts of public policy and economic aspects of wildlife conservation. To encourage participation, a fund has been established to help defray expenses of the participants. 4-H'ers

CHICAGO- Youth provided at the National 4-H completing the course will be grasslands - and recreation. encouraged to use their new knowledge in assisting with community, county and state wildlife conservation programs.

The new wildlife conservation program funded by Atlantic Richfield Foundation is closely related to ongoing 4-H projects and activities in conservation of natural resources - soil, water, forest, range and

camping and community development.

The Extension Service, U.S. Department of Agriculture, reports more than 175,000 young people are presently enrolled in 4-H wildlife conservation projects. The new program is the first nationally sponsored 4-H effort in this area.


