MOORESTOWN, N. J. - A Northeastern Peach Marketing Conference will be held at the Mallard Inn here the evening of Monday, July 11.

Information about peach crop prospects for the Northeastern United States will be the main points of discussion, but there will also be reports about the peach situation in other parts of the nation, and information concerning competing fruits.

Designed to provide information to producers, handlers and buyers, the conference is sponsored jointly by the Cooperative Extension Service at Rutgers University, the New Jersey Peach Promotion Council and the National Peach Council.


