need for additional research and greater flexibility on certain technical aspects of brucellosis eradication was discussed at a recent meeting in Washington, the U.S. Department of Agriculture announced.

Discussion centered upon possible improvements or innovations in specific areas of technology such as:

NEW YORK, N.Y. - The diagnostic procedures, vaccination methods and procedures; areas of research needs; handling of infected birds; indemnity procedures; and surveillance techniques.

The need for better communication with producers about how burcellosis is spread and the steps involved in eradication was also noted.
