Manual available

LEBANON, Pa. - "Animal Waste Management for Environmental Protection" a manual for use by dairy, livestock, and poultry farmers is available from the Lebanon County Conservation District Office.

This free manual can be picked up in the recently relocated office in Room 110 in the County-City Municipal Building. Covered in the manual are guidelines to follow in the daily land application or storage for later application of this valuable soil conditioner and source of plant nutrients.

Farmers planning to increase the number of dairy cows, livestock or poultry on their farms, or planning a change in their method of handling animal wastes should obtain a copy of this office in the Sardon bulding manual.

Alternatives to daily spreading are given with benefits and problems of each system listed.

The Conservation District will provide the farm owneroperator with soil feasibility evaluation and design of earth bank structures if he is planning this type of alternate system.

This manual was prepared by specialists in D.E.R., Agricultural Extension, and the Soil Conservation Service with assistance by representatives of the Pennsylvania Farmers Association, the Grange, and Farmer Union. Limited cost share assistance is also available from Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service north of Lebanon.



He reviewed trade practices in the livestock marketing industry and worked in district offices in Kansas City, Cleveland, Oklahoma City, Chicago and Denver.
