

## Cowtown winners named

WOODSTOWN, N.J.—At the Cowtown Rodeo, on July 16, the saddle bronc event was won by Don Reeder of Woodstown, N.J., with a score of 62. This was his first win of the season at Cowtown.

In the bareback competition, Jimmy Lee Walker placed first with a score of 60. The season's highest winner, in that event Stanley

Thomas, although still bothered by a leg injury, managed to place second in the event.

Because of the hot humid weather, the bulls were temperamental and only four contestants managed to qualify. The winner was rodeo clown T.J. Hawkins, of Reedsville, W. Va., who scored a mark of 64 on a bull named Tractor.

Calf roping was won by Joe Merola of Penn Grove, N.J. He roped his calf in 16.7 seconds for the top money.

Barrel racing was won by Judy Clement of Thorofare, N.J. Judy has placed in every barrel race at Cowtown this year except one.

Ninety one contestants entered the rodeo and performed before 2,000 people. Complete results of the rodeo follow.

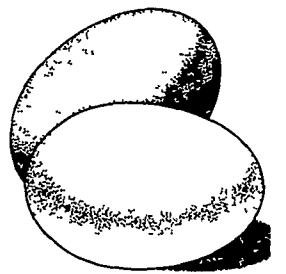

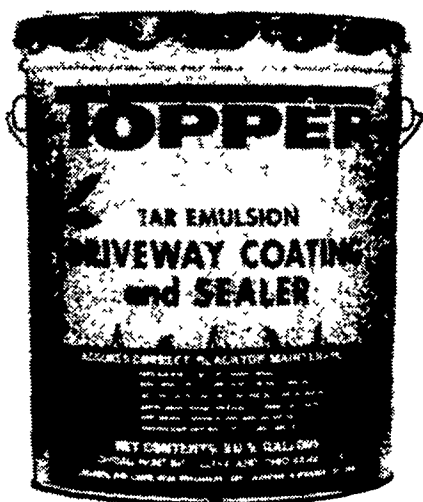

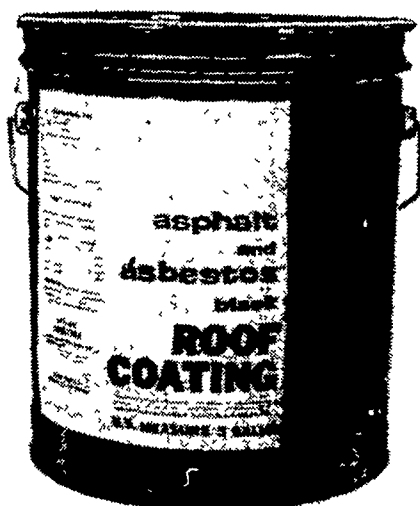
