MF to market Japanese tractors

DES MOINES, Iowa - Massey-Ferguson has signed an agreement with the Toyosha Company Limited of Osaka to market the Japanese company's small farm tractors below 30 horsepower through the Massey-Ferguson worldwide distribution-dealer network.

These small tractors represent a fast growing sector in many markets, now estimated at 50,000 units a year outside Japan and increasing to 100,000 units a year by the early 1980's. Massey-Ferguson, which sells farm machinery in 190 countries, has a current

range of tractors from 34 hp extending up to 190 hp. Also participating in Mitsubishi Corporation which has been the MF distributor in Japan for more than 20 years. Mitsubishi will take an important part in the commercial aspects of the worldwide marketing arrangements.

The tractors will meet Massey - Ferguson's engineering standards and will be sold under the Massey-Ferguson brand name.

The agreement provides for the tractors to be sold with a full range of supporting implements.
