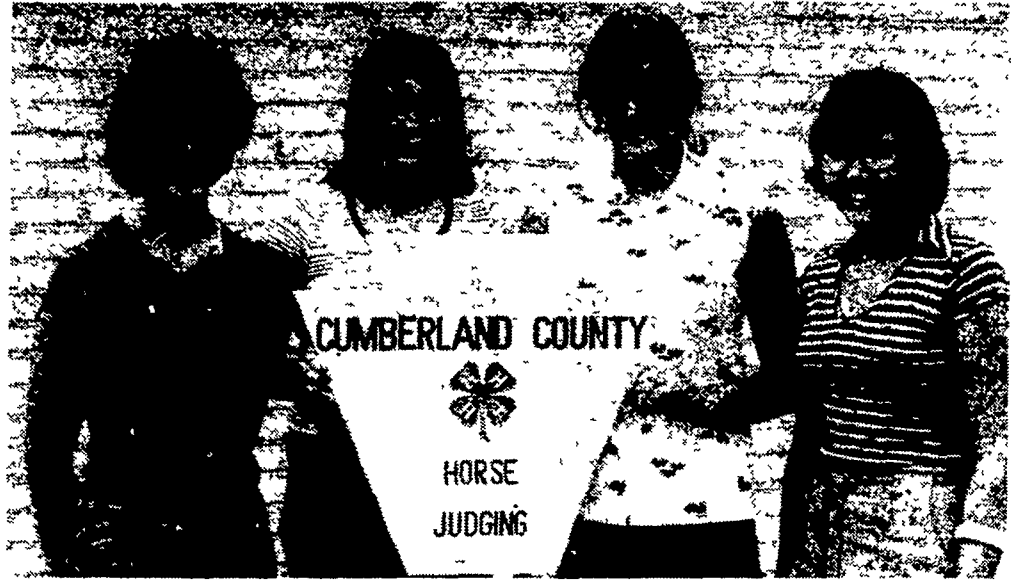

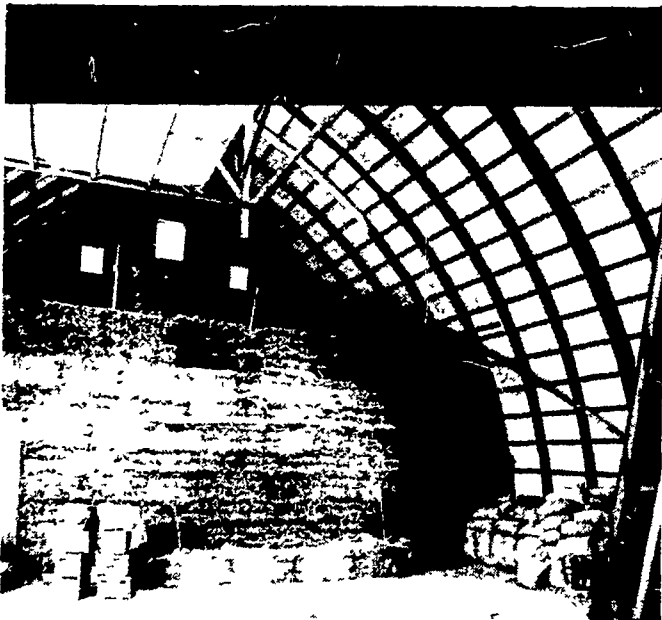
## Achievement Day results:

Three York County 4-H teams are ranked first in the state. They are: The junior livestock team, consisting of Dawn Musser of Man-

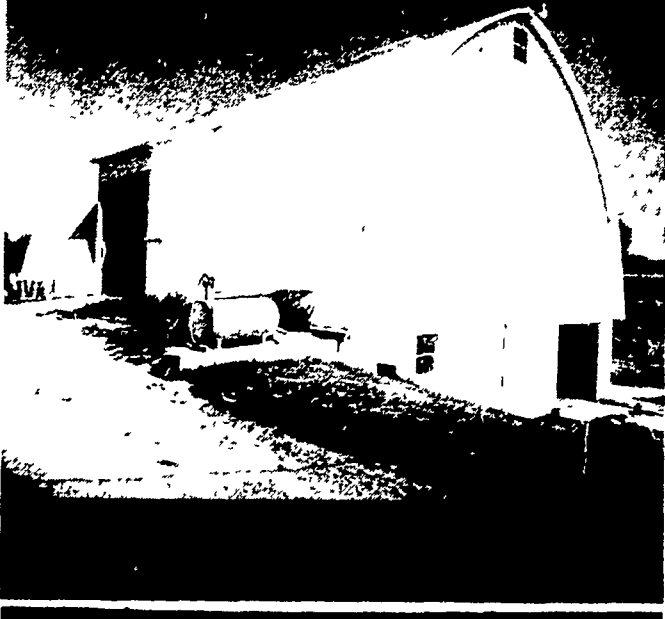
