The meats judging team, consisting of Brenda Warner of Hanover, 2nd individual; Kathy Sunday of York (first); Laurie Dobrosky of Glen Rock 5th individual and David Wise of Spring Grove, third highest individual. The archery team, consisting of Sandy Deel of Stewartstown second; Brooke Palmer of

Shrewsbury, fourth; Greg Elicker, and Randy Breneman, both of York R8, and placing fifth and third, respectively, as individuals

The county which came closest to equalling York County's performance was neighboring Adams County whose 4-H delegation numbered 91. All told, approximately 1500 4-H members competed for honors. Contests were held in

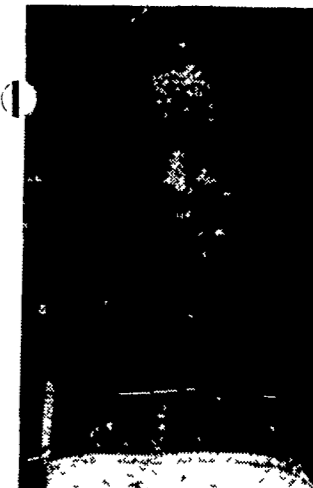
a spirit of competition and fun. But traditional rivalries flourished just as they do in football games and the quadannual Olympics.
Adams County 4-H'ers can boast having four top individuals in the state. They were: Chris Gitt, Littlestown R2, (dairy cattle judging); Judy Smith, Gettysburg R9, (horticulture); Mary Ann Klinger, New Oxford R2, (clothing); and Becky Piper, Gettysburg, (Fooderama).
In addition the Adams County delegation captured

three first-place team plaques. Christine Gitt spearheaded the state's best 4-H dairy cattle judging team. Teammates were Monica Miller, 12th; John Clowney, 34th; and Dan Waybright, all of Gettysburg. The winning horticulture team consisted of Judy Smith, who placed first as an individual; Tom Garretson of Aspers, 9th; Brian Wilson of Biglerville, 12th; and Karen Hobaugh of Abbottstown, 21st. The top clothing team was rounded out by Pat Elicker and Sue Hoke of Abbottstown and

Cindy Reinecker of York Springs. Mary Ann Klinger led the team with her first-place as an individual. All received blue ribbons.
All told, Adams County 4-H'ers captured seven first places, two seconds, four thirds, two fourths, and three fifths. Eight other contestants came in for blue ribbons or gold medals. Details follow in latter parts of this article.
Lancaster County 4-H'ers furnished two top individuals in the state and a first-place team in senior livestock judging. The team consisted

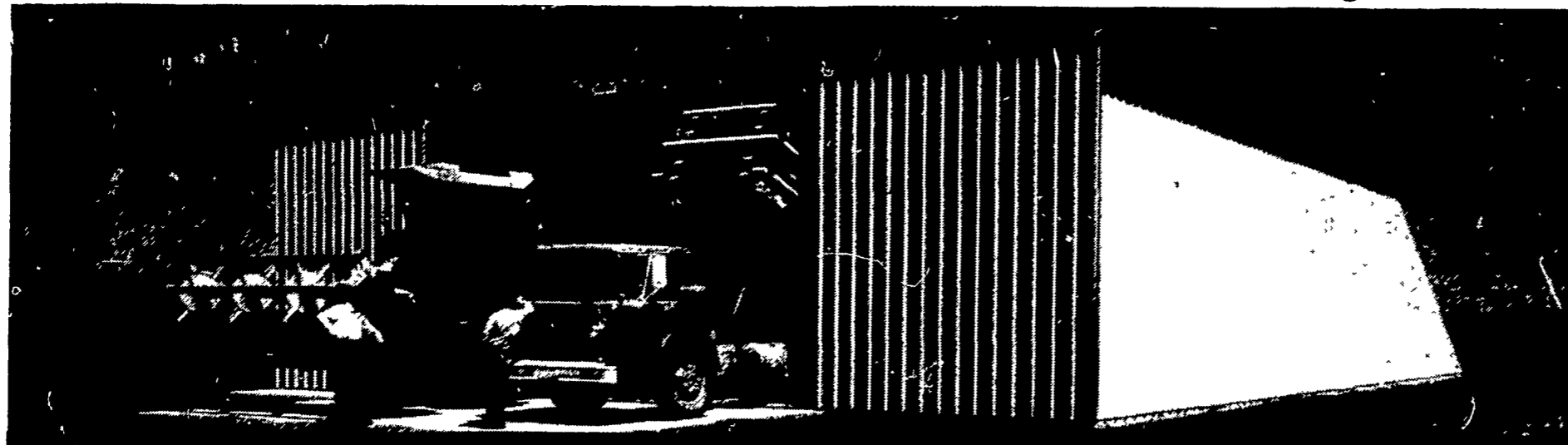

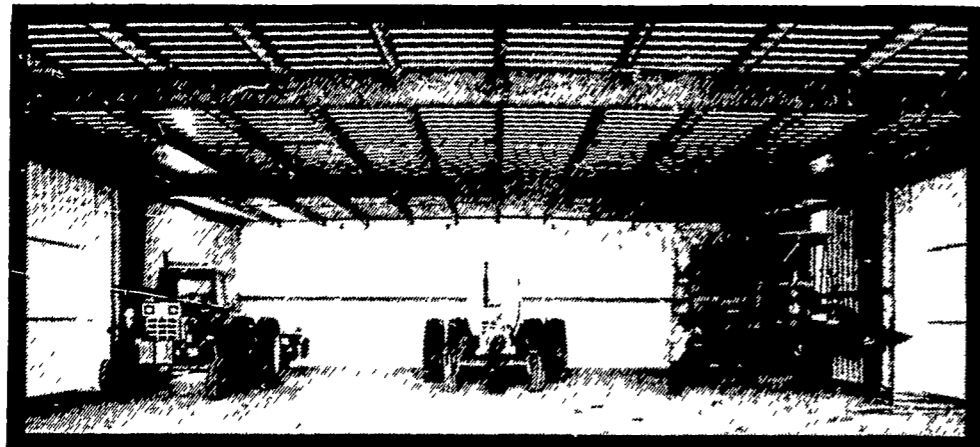
