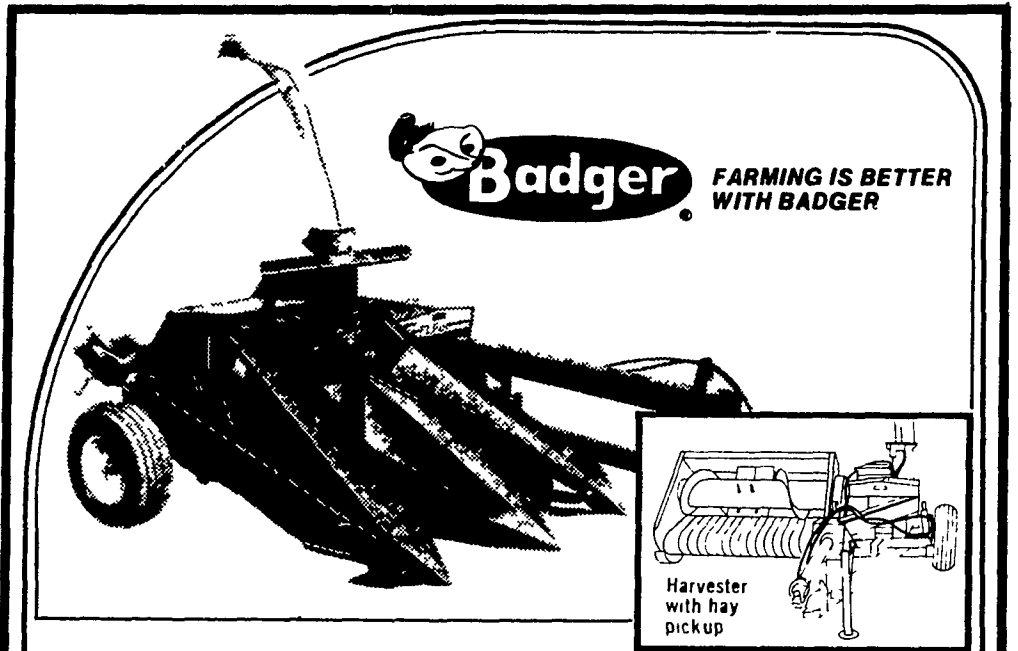

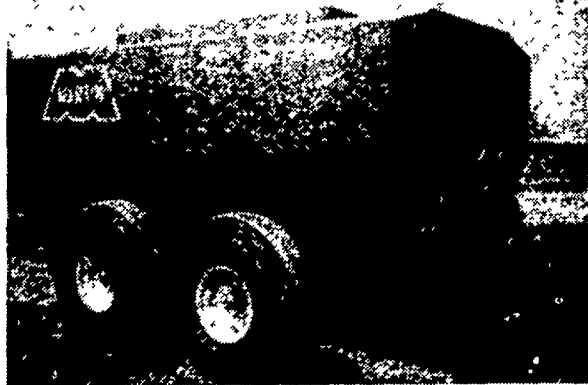

KUTZTOWN, Pa. - A Berks County farm family will be honored on Tuesday, August 16, at the 1977 Kutztown Fair.

An award of \$500 will be given to the winning farm family, while \$100 awards will go to the FFA, FHA and 4-H winners.

This is the first time that the Kutztown Fair has so honored a Berks County grange farm family according to John Schaeffer, chairman of the committee sponsoring the event. But, according to Schaeffer, the Fair Association plans to continue this award from now on.
