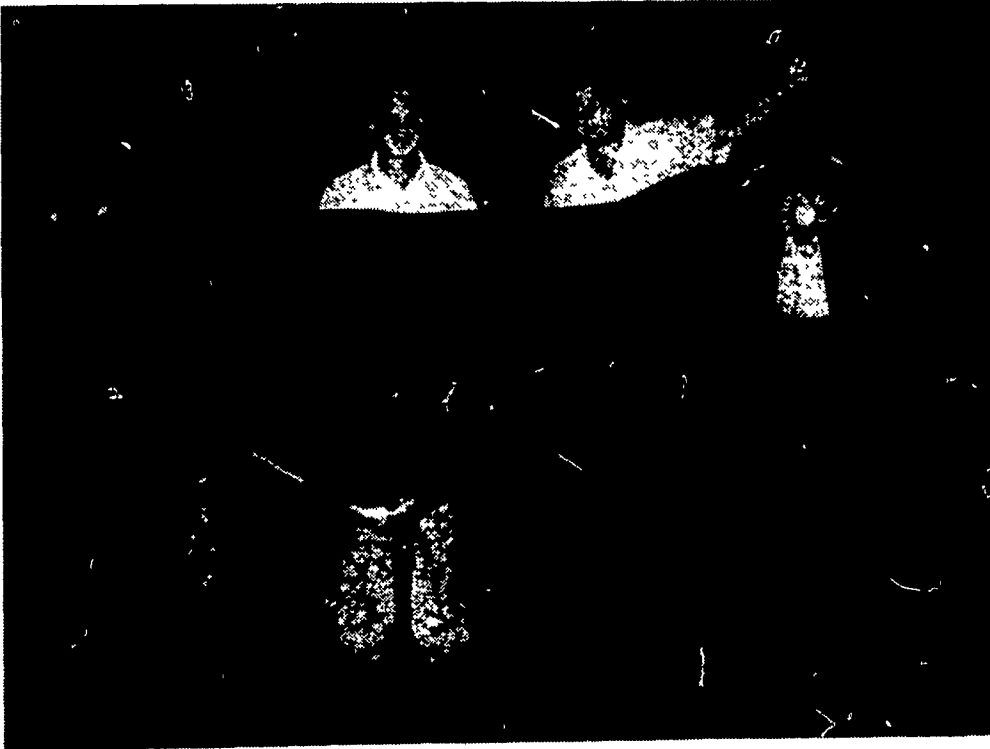


# Cattle shows held
