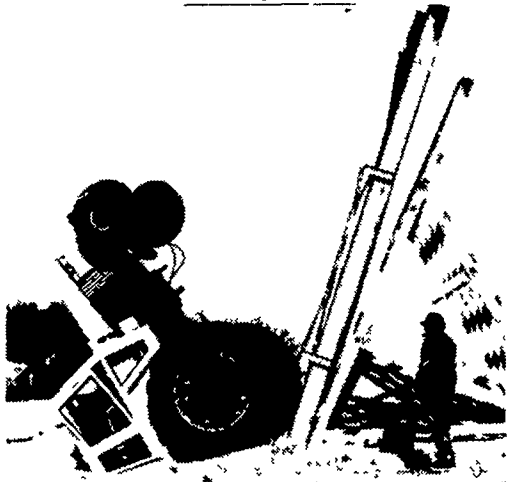

Guernseys noted for production

PETERBOROUGH, N.H. - Three registered Guernsey cows at Crumdale Farm, Berwyn, Pa. owned by Mrs. Eugenia Madeira have lifetime productions of over 125,000 pounds of milk and are still producing.

Friendship Nugget BCN Verbena, a 12-year-old, has produced 133,361 pounds of milk and 5,586 pounds of butterfat in nine lactations which total 3335 days. This is

the equivalent of 31,014 half gallons of milk. Verbena has been classified Excellent three times.

Kelosos Imperial Rene in 10 lactations which total 3,174 days, has produced 132,299 pounds of milk and 5,286 pounds of butterfat. As a six-year-old, she produced 16,500 pounds of milk and 702 pounds of butterfat in 305 days. Rene is classified Very Good and has an August 1976 USDA Cow Index of +356 milk, at 46 per cent repeatability.

Kelosos Rulers Annora, a 14-year-old cow, has 125,699 pounds of milk and 6,667 pounds of fat to her credit in 11 lactations which total 3,608 days. She has been classified Very Good five times.

These records were supervised by Pennsylvania State University.

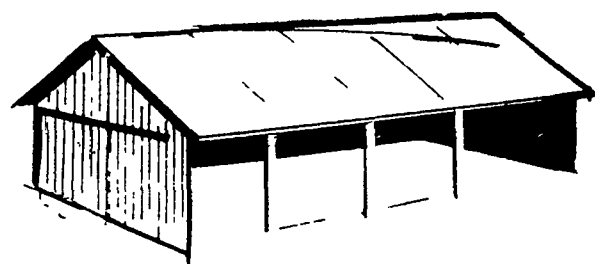
