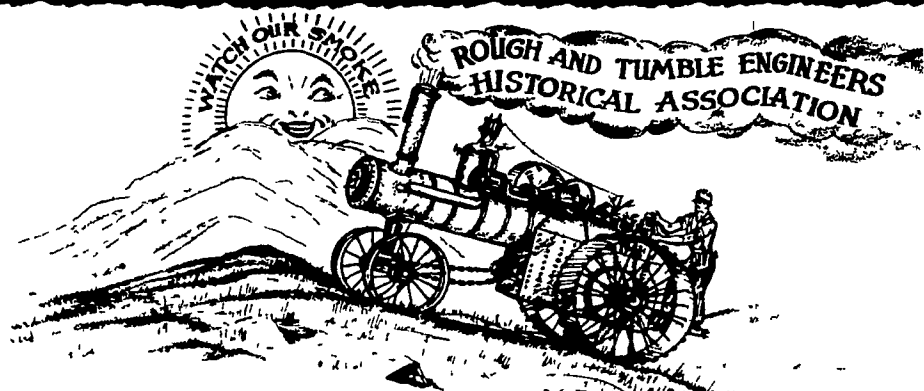
The annual roundup and sale will be held October 11 at Greencastle Livestock
