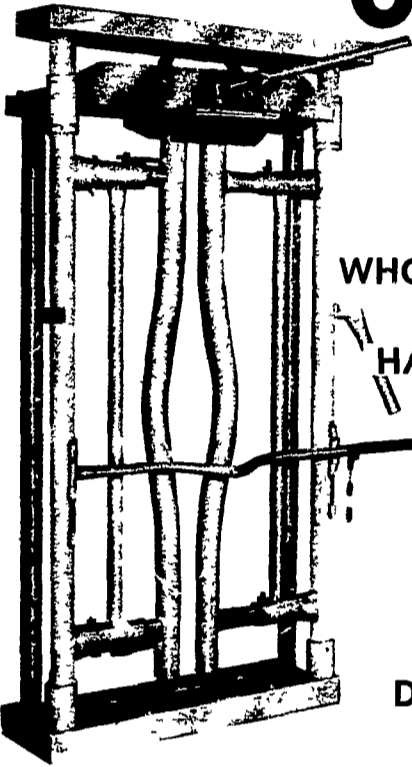
MILKING SHORTHORNS

Brown Swiss

Schuylkill and Lehigh 4-H'ers dominated the Brown Swiss show, taking all but reserve junior champion which went to a Chester County 4-H'er. Grand champion of the show was Dennis Daubert, Pine Grove, while reserve champion went to Bryan Army, Coopersburg.

Junior champion went to Anne Daubert, Pine Grove, followed by Kennard E. Henley III, Cochranville, with reserve junior champion. Other ribbons went to Kathleen Kopistecki, Royersford who had placed second in 3 and 4 year olds and senior calf classes; Michael Kelsch, Barto, who had the first place intermediate calf; Gary Army, Coopersburg, second in junior calf; Allen Daubert, Pine Grove, first in junior yearlings; Scott Hauseman, Oley, second in 2

year olds and third in senior yearlings; and Philip Palmer, Bangor, who placed second in junior yearlings.

County herd in the Brown Swiss breed went to Schuylkill County, followed by, in respective order, Lehigh, Montgomery, and Northampton Counties.

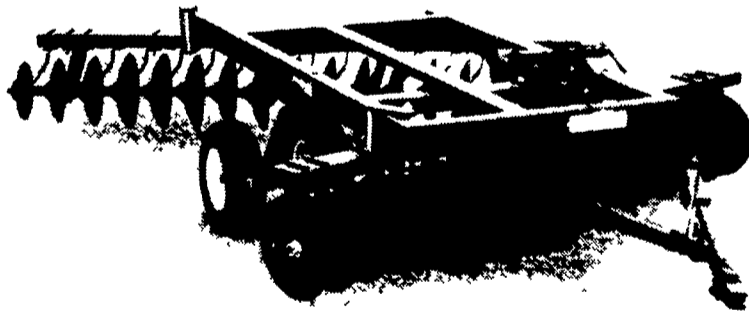

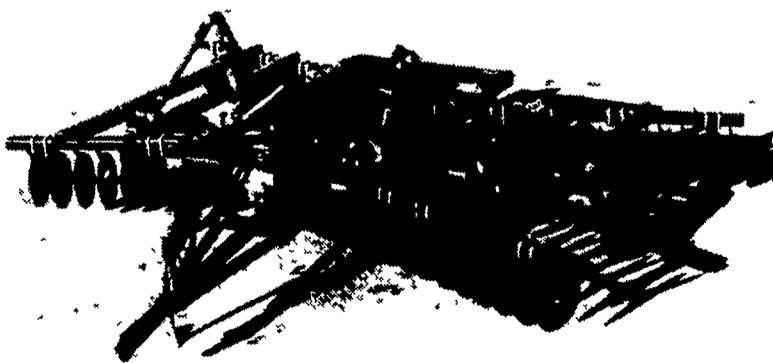

DOUBLE OFFSET TANDEM

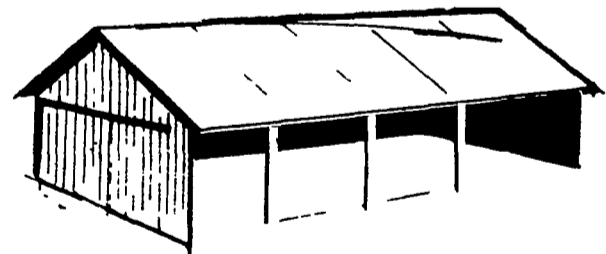

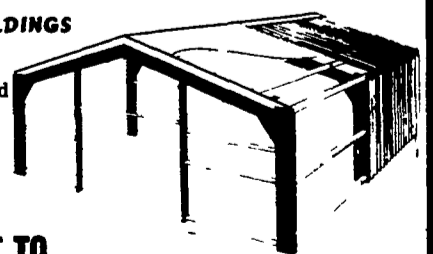
