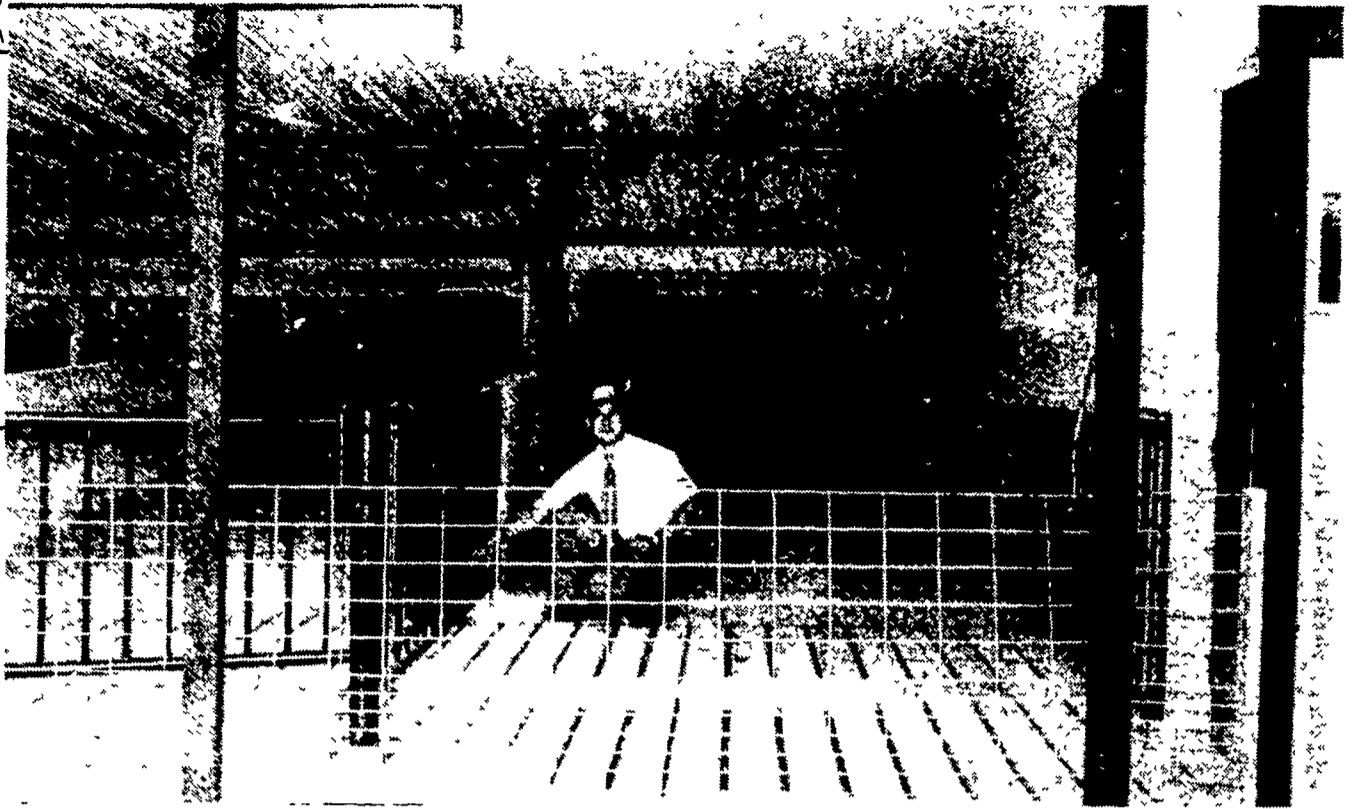


Looking in the front of the Nebraska Unit at the farm of Harold Kurtz, the mono sloped roof, pre cast slats over the manure pit, and the windows in the rear are visible. Although Kurtz had no curtains on the front of his unit, he will be getting nylon curtains which will be thermostatically controlled to regulate the air flow in the structure. Ray Pruss, with the Ralston Purina Company, points to the nipple waterers placed above the slatted floor.

also has a heated floor warmed by hot water.

Room two is set up for 300 90 pounders and allocates 5.5 square feet to each animal. The room also has a heated floor.

The third room for 135 pound animals has no heat on the floor and gives each of the 300 pigs 6.75 square feet.

Room Four, in which the 300 animals finish out from

180 pounds, gives 7.75 square feet to each animal and does not contain a heated floor.

In his operation, Harold Kurtz will be bringing in 300 new pigs every month, moving them through the four rooms, and shipping them out 120 days after they enter.

Rather than having 1200 pigs hit the market at the

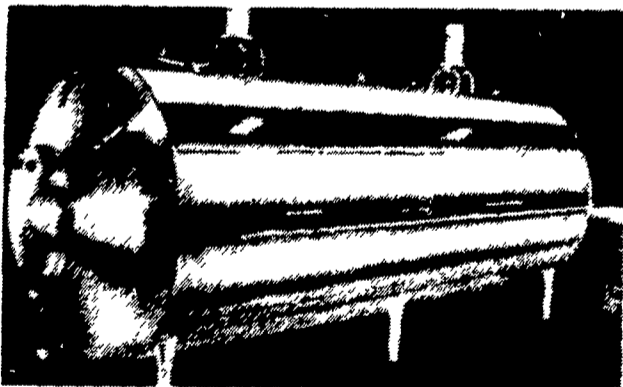
