PUMPKIN PIE SQUARES

1 cup sifted flour ½ cup quick-cooking rolled ⅓ cup brown sugar

purced 1 can evaporated milk (13-1/2

oz.)

2 eggs ½ teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon ½ teaspoon ground ginger

½ cup chopped pecans 1/4 cup brown sugar

rolled oats, brown sugar, and butter in mixing bowl.

baking, combine pumpkin, evaporated milk, eggs, granulated sugar, salt, ground cinnamon, ginger, and cloves in mixing bowl. Beat well. Pour into baked crust and return to oven for 20 minutes. Last of all, combine chopped pecans, brown sugar, and butter. Sprinkle over pumpkin filling. Again, return to oven and bake for 15 to 20 minutes or until filling is set. Cool in pan, then cut into squares. Serve with a dollap of whipped cream.
