

Barbara Herr takes title of open class sheep

YORK, Pa. - A Suffolk wether won grand champion honors for Barbara Herr of Narvon during the September 11 open class market sheep show at the York Fair.

The reserve award went to an animal exhibited by David Huff for Erdenheim Farm, Lafayette Hill.

Judge for the market sheep exhibit was Bill Keck, a former county agent in Bucks County, and an active livestock breeder.

In the lightweight Cheviot class, David Huff was first; Erdenheim Farms, second and third; David Huff, fourth; and James Caudill, fifth. Erdenheim Farms went on to take first place in the heavyweight class and

the breed championship. David Huff won second and third heavyweights, and breed reserve championship.

Nancy Eisenhart, Thomasville, was the lone exhibitor in the Corriedale breed class. She exhibited the first and second lightweight, the first place heavyweight, and the

champion and reserve champion animals.

The Dorset classes were mostly a battle of familiar 4-H exhibitors in York County. Laurie Dobrosky, Glen Rock, capped the first and second places in the lightweight division. Other placings were: third, John Muller, Delta; fourth, Tom Flory, Red Lion; fifth,

Wendy Tracey, Brodbeck's; sixth, Marc Roberson, East Berlin; seventh, John Muller, Delta; eighth, Robert Muller, Delta; ninth, Brian Bankert, Hanover.

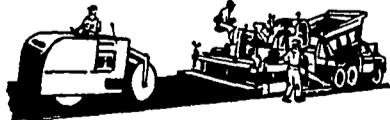

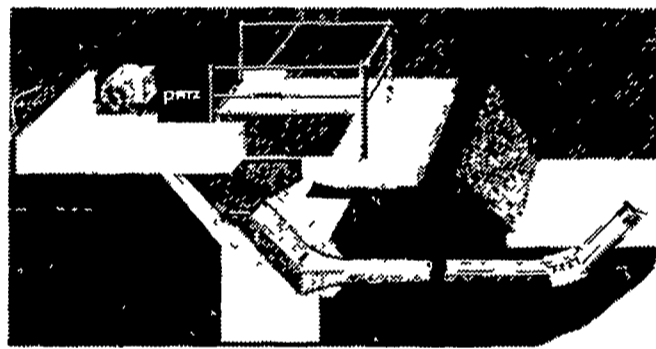

Slurry Manure Pump

Slurry or free flowing manure is pumped from a 180 gallon hopper under ground through 12 in PVC pipe to the manure holding area (If bedding is used only fine cut is recommended) Stroke is adjustable and driven by tough roller chain drive/reduction unit Plunger, sleeve, and one-way valves all can be removed for servicing



Liquid Manure Mover

Big 1700 (US) gallon below-ground pressure vessel collects slurry that is moved simply and easily by as little as 10-12 lbs of air pressure through 12 in PVC pipe to manure storage area Simplicity in design, turning swing-away hatch cover, one-way valve at bottom and flapper valve at the discharge end are the only moving parts
