"Chiquita," a mini-mule owned by Stephanie Jones of Schwenksville, captured the champion ribbon in that event.

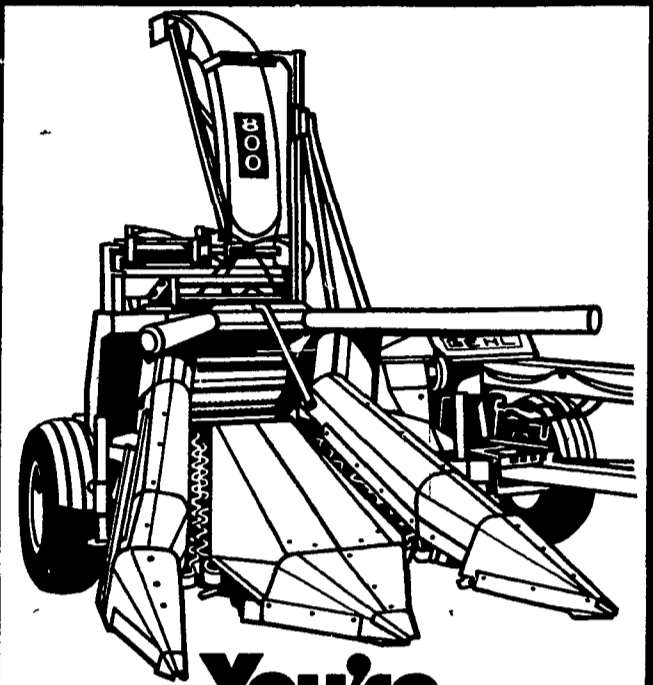

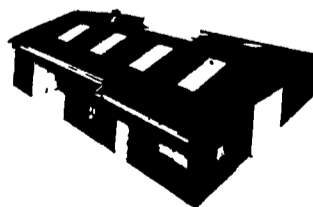
