The arts and crafts display will include demonstrations of delicate wire craft in silver, real leaf jewelry, hand painting on linens, broom making, wood working, the cutting and polishing of gemstones, antiques, paintings, wooden toys, handcrafted pottery, and etc.

In addition to the arts and crafts display, there will be an extensive program of entertainment.

Michael Miller of the Apple Harvest Festival committee reports that, "This year, in addition to the traditional apple related activities we are scheduling the most varied list of performers and entertainers ever seen at the Apple Festival."

The festival, will feature Schwab's Dutch Band, the U.S. Army Military Band, a barbership quartet, the Cannonaders Square Dancing clowns, magicians, puppets, the Fantasyland characters, the Apple Core Band two rock groups, the Penn National Dixieland Band, and the Believers, a gospel singing group.

According to Miller, "We are planning the biggest and best Festival ever with continuous activities and entertainment to please the entire family." Or, visitors can take a free half hour tour of the fruit-laden orchards on a bus that leaves

The second weekend of the festival is highlighted by the crowning of "Miss Apple Queen, U.S.A." Over 14 girls from all over the states will compete for the crown. Preliminary judging takes place at the festival on Saturday, October 8, at 1:00 p.m. The final judging and

crowning ceremonies take place during the Apple Harvest Ball on Saturday evening at the Sheraton Inn, south of Gettysburg.

The Adams County Apple Harvest Festival is sponsored by the Upper Adams Jaycees and will be held Saturdays and Sundays

October 1, 2 and 8, 9, at the South Mountain Fairgrounds, 10 miles north of Gettysburg, on route 234 just west of Arendtsville. Admission to the festival is \$2.00 per adult, children under 16 free.




